All HODs/Offices are hereby informed that the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India has launched a new initiative named National Career Service (NCS) as part of an endeavour to modernise all government-run Employment Exchanges. National Employment Service comprising a network of 978 Employment Exchanges is being transformed into National Career Service (NCS) by leveraging information technology to improve the delivery of services.

The Ministry has also approved a large number of Model Career Centres (MCCs) at various locations to provide a range of employment related services offered under NCS. The Regional Employment Exchange, Panaji has been approved as one of the Model Career Centres and fund for its establishment has been sanctioned and released to the State Government of Goa.

The previous system required job seekers to physically visit the Employment Exchanges for registration, renewal and verification of their records and wait for opportunities to come. Similarly, the employers had to visit Employment Exchanges for posting job vacancies and obtaining a list of eligible candidates with little flexibility. Thus both jobseekers and employers were not satisfied.

The NCS portal provides a nation-wide online platform for jobseekers and employers for job matching in a dynamic, efficient and responsive manner. These facilities along with career counselling content will be delivered by

the portal through a countrywide set-up of career centres, a multilingual call centre, and a network of career counsellors.

NCS also offers a variety of other services like information on skill development courses, apprenticeship, internship, career counselling, etc. All registrations on the NCS Portal are Aadhaar based, with national portability. Data of over 1,18,000 jobseekers registered with the employment exchanges of Goa is on the NCS portal. They can activate their accounts using Aadhaar. States have been requested to publicize usage of the NCS portal for posting vacancies and job matching.

The success of this initiative lies in more and more number of employers registering themselves on NCS portal and using it to post vacancies and recruit candidates. Hence, the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of Goa request you to register your respective department at www.ncs.gov.in and get access to the largest and most reliable database of job seekers of Goa.

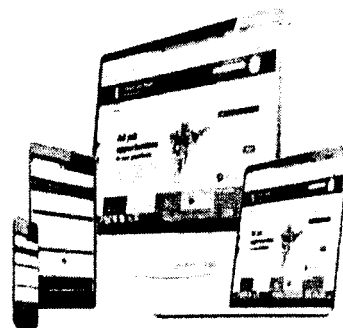

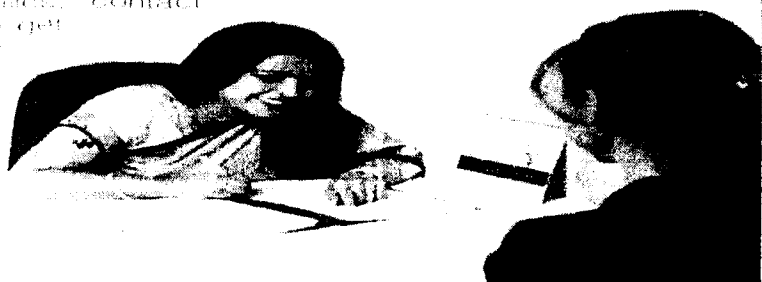
Enabling employers to pick the right talent
