

Incentive to Girls for Secondary Education SC/ST:

Incentive to girls for Secondary Education is Centrally Sponsored Scheme. The objective of the scheme is to established as evaluating environment to reduce the drop out and to promote the enrolment of girl child belonging to SC/ST communities in Secondary Schools ensure their retention up to the 18 years of age. According to the Scheme a sum of Rs. 3000/- will be deposited in the name of each eligible girl and she should be entitled to withdraw it on reaching 18 years of age. All SC/ST girls who pass class VIII and enroll in class IX in the State Government, Government aided or local body schools. The girl should be unmarried and below 16 years of age as an 31st March, an joining class IX to be eligible for the benefit under the scheme. Rs. 18.00 lakhs have been sanctioned from Central Government for the year 2010-11. the out lay proposed 18.90 lakhs for the year 2011-12.
