

Governor launches cashless Raj Bhavan

A bank account for Raj Bhavan has been opened with State Bank of India, Dona Paula Branch, in the name of Comptroller of Governor's Household, through which the purchases will be made after swiping the issued SBI Debit Card on the POS system, for various day-to-day purchases.

On the occasion Principal Secretary to Governor, Dr. Ranbir Singh, IAS, Secretary to Governor, Shri Rupesh Kumar Thakur, IAS, Comptroller of Governor's Household, Shri. A. Kalyana Harsha, Assistant General Manager, State Bank of India (SBI) Shri. Prasanna Kumar P.N, and Branch Manager, SBI, Dona Paula, Ms. Malvika Srivastava were also present.
