

DRY DAYS DURING VILLAGE PANCHAYAT ELECTIONS

The Government has directed that all licensed premises for the sale of liquor and consumption of liquor in public places located within the Panchayat areas where the election for Village Panchayats are being conducted, will be closed from June 10, 2017 till midnight and within the State of Goa from 12.00 a.m. on June 11, 2017 till midnight and on June 13, 2017 from 8.00 a.m. till midnight, in view of polling and counting of votes for the General Elections, 2017 to the 186 Village Panchayats in the State of Goa.

The licensed premises having licence for Bar and Restaurant may be allowed to keep the restaurant open for serving food only and the Bar counter will be closed and no liquor will be allowed to be served on the above mentioned days. The owner of the licensed premises having Bar and Restaurant should also display a board in the premises, stating that no liquor will be served and that only the restaurant is open for serving food.
