

REVENUE MINISTER VISITS CONSTRUCTION SITE OF MULTIPURPOSE HALL AT SALVADOR DO MUNDO

Panaji: July 4, 2017

Minister for Revenue, Shri Rohan Khaunte visited the ongoing construction site of Multipurpose hall, office building and grounds for Village Panchayat Salvador do Mundo Phase II at Salvador Do Mundo today.

The construction of aforesaid project is in progress and the work is executed by Goa State Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. The multipurpose hall building provides facilities like Panchayat office with cabins for Sarpanch and Secretary, a conference room, record room, general staff and service room along with toilets, a Post office, doctors room, veterinary doctors room with space for animals, 13 shops with common toilet facility, Boxing ring, toilet and changing rooms for male and females on the ground floor.

Whereas badminton court, with toilet and changing rooms for male and female, a gymnasium, and rooms for indoor games like chess, carom etc are provided on first floor. Apart from these facilities the other amenities which also will be provided are tennis court as per standard size, a multipurpose hall with the capacity of 300 people a football ground and parking for 45 vehicles.

The estimated cost of the said project is Rs. 24 crores and would be completed by September 2017.
