

SECTION 144 (1) IMPOSED DURING ASSEMBLY SESSION

Panaji, December 12, 2017

Agrahayana, 21, 1939

In view of 4th session of Seventh Legislative Assembly of the State of Goa convened at 11.30 a.m. from December 13 to 18, 2017 the District Magistrate in North Goa has prohibited the assembly and gathering of five or more persons and taking out or organizing of processions. The carrying of firearms or weapons of offences such as lathis, swords, daggers or spears. The use of loudspeakers. The shouting of slogans, burning of fire crackers near the petrol pumps and at the venues of meetings, etc. in any public place, street, road, square, thoroughfare, bye-lane or in any open space within the radius of 500 meters around the Assembly Complex at Porvorim and the area under the jurisdiction of Panaji Police Station.

The above restriction will not apply to public servants on duty and to bonafide marriage or funeral procession or any special occasion or occasions which in the opinion of the District Magistrate/Additional District in writing has/have been be obtained from the District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate or the Sub-Divisional Magistrate concerned.

This order shall come into force w.e.f. 7.00 a.m. from December 13, 2017 and will remain in force till the Assembly Session is over. **DI/NB/TSS/JA/GJG/GD/2017/1155**
