Sub:- Floral tribute at the Martyrs' Memorial at Azad Maidan, Panaji Goa on 30.01.2018.

Floral tribute at the Martyrs' Memorial at Azad Maidan, Panaji will be paid on the 30th January, 2018. The detailed programme will be as below:-

- 10.40 a.m..... Patriotic songs by the Children of Bal Bhavan. L
- 10.45 a.m..... Arrival of Chief Secretary.
- 10.50 a.m..... Arrival of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Hon.Speaker, Ministers and other dignitaries. Chief Secretary will receive the Hon. Chief Minister at Azad Maidan. DDA
- 10.55 a.m..... Arrival of Hon'ble Governor of Goa. She will be received by Hon'ble Chief Minister, chief Secretary and Director General of Police.
- 10.57 a.m..... Patriotic songs conclude.
- 10.58 a.m..... Hon'ble Governor of Goa places the wreath on the Martyrs' Memorial followed by Hon'ble Chief Minister and other dignitaries.
Guard gives command "Salami Shastr" and "Shok Shastr". All Officers in uniform salute till the last note of the Last Post is played. Others stand in attention.
- 11.00 a.m..... Upon culmination of the 'Last Post', the Police fire single shot of gun fire in air to signal the start of two minutes silence, during which all stand in attention with heads bowed.
- 11.02 a.m..... Police fires a second shot of gun fire in air to signal the end of two minutes silence. The Guard gives command 'Salami Shastr' and Bugles sound the 'Rouse'. All officers in uniform salute. Others stand in attention. The Guard gives Command order 'Bazu Shastr'.
2. The Hon'ble Governor of Goa leaves and is seen off by Hon'ble Chief Minister, Chief Secretary and Director General of Police.
3. The Director of Bal Bhavan is requested to make arrangements to provide children of Bal Bhavan for singing Patriotic songs. It may be ensured that the children remain present at Azad Maidan well in advance.

4. The Director General of Police, Panaji is requested to make arrangements of the Police Guard of Honour and the Police Band. He is also requested to make necessary arrangements for diversion of traffic around the Azad Maidan. The road behind the Memorial may be closed for 10 minutes from 10.55 am. to 11.05 am for the public keeping in view the solemnity of the ceremony.
 5. The Director of Information is requested to provide necessary sound system and one table for the children of Bal Bhavan for singing Patriotic songs. He is also requested to kindly issue a suitable press note requesting the Freedom Fighters to attend the function. He should take necessary action for press, T.V. and photo coverage of the function.
 6. The Director of Sports and Youth Affairs Panaji, and Director of Education, Panaji are requested to ensure that the children are properly escorted by the teacher's In-charge before and after the function. **It may also be ensured to make arrangement of refreshment/snacks to the 25 children and accompanists during the function and refreshment to be provided to the children in respective schools before they are brought to Azad Maidan for the function.**
 7. The Executive Engineer, Work Division -I. P.W.D., Panaji and the Commissioner, Corporation of City of Panaji are requested to bruce up the Azad Maidan and surrounding area and for proper upkeep of the Memorial and also ensure that the vicinity is kept clean and tidy and is beautified with vases of crotons/flowers.
 8. The President of Goa, Daman and Diu, Freedom Fighters Association, Panaji and Freedom Fighters Association-Goa, Ponda-Goa are requested to bring the above programme to the notice of Freedom Fighters for the purpose of attending the function.
 9. In view of above programme, all the Secretaries, Head of Department/Offices/Joint Secretaries and Under Secretaries in the Secretariat and staff of all Government Offices situated at Panaji and nearby areas should assemble at the Azad Maidan to observe two minutes silence on 30th January, 2018 at 11.00 a.m. sharp.
