

CONSTITUTION WEEK CELEBRATED

The Constitution Week Celebrations were held at Sanguem, Quepem, Canacona and across the State at the initiative of the Governor, Dr.(Smt) Mridula Sinha by Directorate of Higher Education and Department of Political Science, Goa University.

At a function organised at Canacona, today, Smt Shruti Nadkarni, Assistant Professor, Govind Ramnath Kare College of Law, Margao said Right to equality, Right to freedom, right against exploitation, right to freedom of religion, cultural and educational right and right to constitutional remedies are the six fundamental rights bestowed on us by the Constitution.

It lays down the National goal of the country besides providing a set of basic rules that allows for minimal coordination and assurance amongst members of society, she pointed.
