The survey would cover all the higher education institutions in the State and data would be collected on several parameters such as teachers, student's enrolment, programmes, examination, results, financial parameters, infrastructure, indicators of educational development, such as institutional Density, Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) Students Teacher Ratio, Gender Parity Index etc. The report which will be published would be the bedrock of information upon which the policy decision of Higher Education would be made.

The Directorate is inviting suggestions/inputs from the general public regarding the broad spectrum and parameters that should be captured in order to make the report an exhaustive one.
