

NOBEL PRIZE SERIES, INDIA 2018 AT GOA

The Department of Science & Technology, Government of Goa, will host a mega International science event “Nobel Prize Series – 2018 from February 1 to February 3, 2018 with Nobel Exhibition from February 1 to February 28, 2018. The event is organised in collaboration with Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India, New Delhi and Nobel Media AB, Sweden.

This event is aimed to generate scientific temperament and science students by educational upgradation. The purpose is to focus on the importance of Science, in order to inspire the young students to pursue education and career in science for innovation and scientific growth.

The event will benefit school students as well as students at college level; students of technical institutions and researchers. On February 1, 2018 the Nobel Exhibition will be inaugurated at Kala Academy by Hon’ble Chief Minister, Government of Goa followed by inaugural function. Five Nobel Laureates will attend the inaugural event along with besides Secretary to Department of Bio-Technology, Ministry of Science & Technology, Govt of India, Padmashree Prof. Vijay Raghavan and other Government of India officials.

On February 2, 2018 there will be Nobel Dialogue at Kala Academy in the morning session with students and in the afternoon session with the teachers.

Similarly, on February 3, 2018 there will be a Nobel Dialogue with students and teachers of High Schools and Higher Secondary Schools (Science Stream) at Ravindra Bhavan, Margao.
