

LIQUOR OUTLETS TO BE CLOSED DURING PANCHAYAT BYE-ELECTION

The Government has directed that all licensed premises for sale and consumption of liquor in public places located within the jurisdiction of Guirdorim Ward No. III, Carmona Ward No. VII in Salcett and Querim-Tiracol Ward No. I in Pernem will be closed from 12.00 midnight of November 24, 2018, till 12.00 midnight of November 26, 2018.

However, the licensed premises having a license for Bar and Restaurant may be allowed to keep the restaurant open for serving food only. Bar counter will be closed and no liquor will be served on the mentioned date and time. The owners of the Bars and Restaurants should also display a board in the premises stating no liquor will be served and that the restaurant will be open for food only.

The Government has also directed that no liquor will be transported from one place to another within the jurisdiction of wards given above in Pernem and Salcet Taluka from 12.00 midnight of November 24, 2018, till 12.00 midnight of November 26, 2018. The maximum quantity of liquor which can be possessed by any person without permit is three quart bottles of Indian made foreign liquor or foreign liquor other than beer and six bottles of beer 650ml for any person including his family and three quart bottles of country liquor for any person including his family in view of polling and counting of votes.
