

SEC 144 IMPOSED AT GOVT COLLEGE, BORDA FOR COUNTING

The District Magistrate and District Election Officer, South Goa District, Margao, have imposed Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, on the day of counting of votes i.e. May 23 & 24, 2019, from 06.00 hrs till the end of counting of votes at Government College of Commerce and Economics, Borda, Margao to conduct the counting of votes in free and fair manner and to maintain public peace, order and tranquility.

The District Magistrate have ordered all Hotels, Restaurants, Establishments, Bars, Tea Shops, Pan Shops and other food shops (Dhabas, Gaddas) etc. on either side of the road from Old Survey Office, Borda to Agalli Junction to remain close to avoid their misuse and to prevent any gathering of crowd and any law and order problem. There shall also be no parking of vehicles on this said route and no vehicles belonging to the public would be allowed to be plied on this route, except of those who live within the said prohibited area who would have to show proof of identity having address mentioned on it to the officials deployed on duty.
