Whereas, the Vasco Urban Co-op. Credit Society Ltd., 3 Commerce Centre, Vasco-da-Gama, Goa, hereinafter referred as "said society", was registered with the office of Assistant Registrar, Co-op. Societies, South Zone, Margao vide code symbol No. 8-RES(a)-49/South Goa/91 dated 15-7-1991 and classified as "Resource Society".

And whereas, the Committee of Administrator was appointed vide order No. 19/12/96/UCCS/TS/RCS/4076 dated 7th June, 2011 to streamline the affairs of the society due to the resignation by Board of Directors of the society.

And whereas, as per terms and conditions of the order at Sr. No. 1 above, the election process was initiated and accordingly new Board of Directors was elected on 3-7-2014. The said newly elected Board of Directors has taken over charge of the society from Committee of Administrator w.e.f. 17-7-2014.

And whereas, subsequent upon the election of new Board of Directors and taking over the charge of the said society, the majority of the said elected Board of Directors tendered their resignation and fresh Committee of Administrators was constituted vide order No. 19/01/2014/VUCCS/TS/RCS/Vol. I/917 dated 18th June, 2015, to fill the vacuum created.

And whereas, the Administrative control of said society since the resignations of Board of Directors was under the Administrator appointed by the Registrar from time to time. There are also series of complaints from the members/depositors of the society for non-payment of their term deposits by the society. The allegations of the said members/depositors were also against the committee members of the Administrative Committee for non-cooperation in sorting out the said issue. The audited statements certifies that the society is having ₹ 2,14,60,157=31 amount of deposits as on 31-3-2017.

And whereas, the OTS scheme was floated by the society to bridge the gap of financial equilibrium from its deteriorated situation. The said scheme was also approved by the Government. However, desired results and purpose for which the scheme was implemented was not served. The financial position of the said society has also not shown any sign of improvement with the introduction of said scheme.

And whereas, the present Committee of Administrator under the chairmanship of Shri Raju Magdum, has submitted detailed status report vide letter dated 27-2-2018, stating the practical difficulties faced in managing the day to day affairs of the society and also informed that mass resignation tendered by the entire staff of the society, crunch of funds leading to problem for settlement of time and demand liability, etc. The Administrator expressed inability to manage the business of the society, thereby exposing the depositors to resort to chaotic situation thereby reiterated the inability to manage the affairs of the society.

And whereas, the prime lender of the society i.e. The Goa State Co-op. Bank Ltd., Panaji-Goa vide its letter No. GSCB/I&A/2017-18/44/4149 dated 18-7-2017 has requested this office to liquidate the proceedings of the society. The said creditor bank is having ₹ 2,34,87,873=00 amount outstanding as loan as on 31-3-2017, alongwith interest payable amounting to ₹ 2,17,15,004=00.

And whereas, inspection reports dated 2-4-2015 and 12-4-2017 submitted by the concerned inspecting officers has passed strictures covering the negative working trend of the society, which were leading the society into financial crisis.

And whereas, under the above circumstances it reveals that, the elected Board of Directors and the Committee of Administrators has failed to manage the affairs of the society and streamline the business as per the of the Goa Co-operative Societies Act, 2001, Rules, 2003 made thereunder and the bye laws of the society. Considering the overall financial position and taking into consideration the interests of the depositors/ members, the matter was even referred to the Government and after taking into account the facts on record it is consider to put the society into liquidation, as the very purpose for which the society registered is found to be defeated. Thus, considering all the above viewpoints the existence of the society will not serve any purpose and therefore it is decided to wind-up the affairs of the society.

Hence, following order is passed.

ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested in me under Section 92(c)(ii) of the Goa Co-operative Societies Act, 2001, I, Sanjiv M. Gadkar, Registrar of Co-operative Societies, hereby direct and order that "The Vasco Urban Co-op. Credit Society Ltd., 3

Commerce Centre, Vasco-da-Gama, Goa," registered under code symbol No. 8-RES(a)-49/South Goa/91 dated 15-7-1991 be wound up.

Further, in exercise of the powers vested in me under Section 93(1) of the Goa Co-operative Societies Act, 2001 read with Rule 129, I hereby appoint The Goa State Co-operative Bank Ltd., Panaji-Goa as the Liquidator of The Vasco Urban Co-op. Credit Society Ltd., 3 Commerce Centre, Vasco-da-Gama, Goa on below mentioned terms and conditions viz.

- 1) The Liquidator shall settle the liabilities of the members/depositors and other account holders of the society in the ratio of 50:50 i.e. amount recovered will be utilized first to repay the liabilities of the depositors strictly and the balance 50% shall be deducted against the loan account of Goa State Co-op. Bank Ltd., Panaji-Goa.
- 2) The Liquidator Bank shall deploy the required staff having sound knowledge of recovery and execution of cases without any additional financial burden on the society.
- 3) The Liquidator Bank pursue criminal cases filed against all the office bearers of the society who are responsible for missing of records/documents and overall financial mess. Further, it is directed to assess the overall status and may file additional criminal/civil cases against the concerned responsible persons and may refer the matter to the Economic Offence Cell for conducting detailed investigation and fixing responsibility of the concerned persons for such economic offence.
- 4) The Liquidator Bank, while discharging the duties in capacity of liquidator shall exercise all the powers conferred under Section 95 of Goa Co-op. Societies Act, 2001 and Rules made thereunder.
- 5) The Liquidator Bank shall furnish a monthly report on the status of liquidation proceedings to the Asstt. Registrar of Co-op. Societies, South Zone by endorsing a copy of the same to this Authority on or before 5th of succeeding month.
