CIRCULAR

Sub: Mandate for granting construction permits in Industrial Development Corporations.

The Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP), Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India, New Delhi has undertaken the initiative of Ease of Doing Business (EoDB).

Government of Goa is committed to ensure EoDB and establish better investment climate in the State.

In order to comply with the Recommendation No. 236 of Business Reforms Action Plan, 2017 of DIPP under EoDB to simplify the procedure for issue of construction permits/ licenses and occupancy certificate in any of the notified Industrial Estate, Government has approved the mechanism of single, joint site inspection by all concerned authorities such as Public Works Department (Water Supply, Sewerage, Roads, & Highways), Electricity Department, Health Department, Fire Department, Forest Department, Directorate of Factories and Boilers and all other concerned authorities with Goa Industrial Development Corporation (Goa-IDC), being the Nodal Agency.

Once an applicant submits an application for construction license/ occupancy certificate in any of the notified Industrial Estate, Goa-IDC being Nodal Agency shall issue a notice to the applicant under intimation to all the concerned authorities and fix up date and time for a joint inspection of the site. Thereafter, necessary permissions will be issued.

To further ensure transparency and ease business environment in the State, the joint site inspection within Industrial Estate will be carried on first and third Wednesday of every month (in case of notified holiday on above mentioned days. Joint inspection will be carried out on next working day).

All concerned departments shall take the appropriate action accordingly.
