

GOVERNOR HOLDS MEETING WITH TELANGANA KALA PARISHATH

Governor of Goa, Smt.Mridula Sinha held a meeting with Shri Pagidipalli Raja Rao, Founder and President of Telangana Kala Parishath at Raj Bhavan today.

Shri Pagidipalli Raja Rao, while interacting with the Governor said Telangana Kala Parishath was established with a sole objective to proclaim culture and tradition for the World Peace. He pointed that they have launched “Save Farmer- Build Nation” nationwide culture campaign a pioneering initiative by Telangana Kala Parishath to prevent suicides by farmers, he added. Our country is an agrarian country with around 70% depending directly or indirectly upon agriculture. Farmer suicides account for 11.2% of all suicides in India. As a social responsibility they have been reaching farmers through culture campaign “ Save Famer-Build Nation” he said.

Shri Rao impressed upon the Governor to take necessary steps to implement Crop Insurance System, Location-Specific Policy for Irrigation, make available best irrigation technology and implementation of Zero-budget natural farming. He further said Agriculture land reduction due to urbanization has become a serious problem and requested Governor to support their cultural campaign to make the nation the best for farmers.
