

**LATE RANADE'S ASTHI KALASH TO BE KEPT FOR PUBLIC  
DARSHAN ON JULY 3**

**Panaji, July 2, 2019**

Goa's prominent Freedom Fighter late Padma Shri Mohan Ranade's *Asthi Kalash* will arrive in Goa on July 3, 2019, at 11.30 a.m. Chief Minister Dr. Pramod Sawant will receive the *Asthi Kalash* at Institute Menezes Braganza Hall (IMB), Panaji at 11.30a.m. The *Asthi Kalash* will be open for public *darshan* at IMB till 4.30p.m. after which it will be taken for immersion to river Mandovi.

Born in 1929 at Sangli in Maharashtra, Ranade had participated in the Goa liberation movement. He was an integral member of the Azad Gomantak Dal, an army of like-minded youngsters who acquired arms and carried out surprise attacks on the Portuguese. He was awarded the Padma Shri in 2001.
