Whereas it appears to the Government of Goa (hereinafter referred to as "the Government") that the land specified in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as the "said land") is likely to be needed for public purpose viz. Approach road of 8.0 m. span culvert at Rassaim including Palonda stretch in Y. P. Loutolim of Salcete Taluka.
