# FERTILIZER CONTROL ORDER 1985

Fertilizer Control Order 1985: Registrations certificate/letter of Authorization for Retail/Wholesale Fertilizer dealers are issued under clause 7 of Fertilizer Control Order (FCO) 1985.

## **I. Registration of New Dealers: (by online mode only)**

Documents required:-:

1. Application form 'A1'
2. B.Sc.Agri/Chem / Diploma in Agriculture Science / Certificate course on Agriculture inputs for minimum period of 06 months. (Provided that the dealers , who have been granted authorization letter, before the commencement of the Fertilizer (control) Fourth Amendment order, 2015 shall not be required to possess the qualifications at the time of renewal of their authorization letter) .
3. Copy of Registration Certificate from Department of Commercial Taxes.
4. Recommendation of Fertilizer Inspector.
5. Fee of Rs 600/- for wholesale LOA and dealer and Rs 300/- for Retail LOA dealer and the acknowledgement will be valid for a period of 3 years and issued in Form A2.
6. Certificate of source of supply fertilizer under Form "O" from company.
7. Location Plan /Site plan.
8. NOC from Municipality / Village panchayat.
9. Copy of Legal documents of premises i.e.Deed of sale/Lease.
10. Aadhar card, Election card, TIN number, Pan card, Contact Number.

## **II. Renewal of registration certificate/Letter of Authorization (LOA): (by online mode only)**

Documents required:-

1. Certificate of source of supply of fertilizer under Form "O" from company.
2. Original Certificate/Letter of Authorization.
3. Recommendation of Fertilizer Inspector.
4. Renewal fee of Rs.400/- for wholesale and Rs.200/- for retailer. Late fee of Rs.200/-and Rs.75/- wholesaler and retailer is applicable respectively if the application is submitted within one month of expiry date. The renewed LOA will be valid for further period of 3 years.

## **III. Amendments to LOA: (by online mode only)**

Documents required:-

1. Application on plain paper.
2. Certificate of source of supply in Form "O" from company.
3. Original Letter of Authorization.
4. Amendment fee of Rs.30/- per product for wholesale and Rs.20/- per product for retailer after due recommendation of fertilizer Inspector.

#### **IV. Duplicate/Additional copy of certificate: (by online mode only)**

Documents required:-

1. Application on plain paper
2. Fee of Rs.50/- for wholesaler and Rs.20/- for retailer.

#### **V. Registration certificate for sale of Organic fertilizers**

Sale of organic fertilizers and Bio-fertilizers require Registration Certificate/Letter of Authorization from Directorate of Agriculture Organic fertilizers like city compost, organic manure, Vermi compost and Bio fertilizers like Rhizobium, Azatobacter, Acetobacter and Azospirillum are brought under the perview of FCO 1985.

Procedure to obtain Letter of Authorization

1. Site Plan/Sketch showing Manufacturing Unit/Storage point.
2. List of Laboratory facilities available
3. Name and address of Compliance Officer designated for FCO purposes.
4. Analysis report of the product.
5. Inspection report of fertilizer inspector
6. NOC of Pollution Control Board, Factories and Boilers.
7. Bagging and packing details.

# **INSECTICIDE ACT, 1968:**

## **1. Issue of manufacturing license:- (by online mode only)**

Any manufacturer of insecticide or obtaining desiring to do so after registration certificate for the manufactured from products desired to be Central Insecticide Committee (CIB & RC) Board and Registration, Faridabad.

Procedure & format to obtain certificate/license:

1. Apply in Form V for grant of license giving details of registration of insecticides to be manufactured, name(s) of expert persons, safety provision etc.
2. Certificates of registration
3. Form XXII
4. List of Lab equipment
5. List of Machinery and manufacturing equipment
6. List of Personals employed
7. List of safety equipment
8. Payment of a fee of Rs.2000/- for each insecticide to be manufactured subject to a maximum of Rs.20, 000/- for each place of manufacture.

Procedure for Renewal of certificate/license

1. Apply in Form V for grant of license giving details of registration of insecticides to be manufactured, name(s) of expert persons, safety provision etc.
2. Original Manufacturing License
3. Certificates of registration
4. Form XXII
5. List of Lab equipment
6. List of Machinery and manufacturing equipment
7. List of Personels employed
8. List of safety equipment

## **2. Issue of license to sell, stock, or exhibit for sale or distribute insecticides: (by online mode only)**

Any person desirous of trading in pesticides/dealers of pesticides.

Procedure & format to obtain certificate/license:

The Applicant should be B.Sc in Agri /Chemistry Or Should employ person with above qualification on regular basis.

1. Application in Form VII
2. List of Insecticide to be proposed for Stock, Sale & Exhibit.
3. Copy of Registration Certificate from Department of Commercial Taxes.
4. Valid Principal Certificate from manufacturer. Original duly completed viz Certificate No, date, date of issue, validity, name & signature of dealer.
5. Location Plan /Site plan.

6. Copy of NOC from Municipality / Village Panchayat.
7. Copy of Legal documents of premises –Deed of sale/Lease
8. List of Staff, Qualification & their position.
9. B.Sc qualified employee with certificate , aadhar card, Mobile No.
10. List of Safety Equipment.
11. Aadhar card, Election card, TIN number, Pan card, Mobile Number /Email address
12. Payment of a fee of Rs. 500/- per insecticide subject to a maximum of Rs.7500/- for each place of stocking/sale etc.

### **3. Issue of License for grant of License/Renewal of License to stock and use of Insecticide for commercial Pest Control Operation:**

1. Application in Form VII

The Applicant should be B.Sc in Agri / Chemistry with 15 days course at National Plant Health Management Institute, Hyderabad or Central Food Training and Research Institute, Mysore. Or should employ person with above qualification on regular basis.

2. List of proposed Services .
3. List of Insecticide to be used for the proposed services
4. Copy of Registration Certificate from Department of Commercial Taxes.
5. Valid Principal Certificate from manufacturer. Original duly completed viz Certificate No, date, date of issue, validity, name & signature of dealer .
6. Location Plan /Site plan.
7. NOC from Municipality / Village panchayat.
8. Copy of Legal documents of premises –Deed of sale/Lease
9. List of Staff , Qualification & their position.
10. B.Sc. qualified employee with certificate , adhaar card, Mobile No .
11. List of Safety Equipment.
12. Adhar card, Election card, TIN number, Pan card, Mobile Number /Email address
13. Payment of fee of Rs 1000/-, the license is valid for 3 calendar year

### **4. Phytosanitary Certificate:**

1. All persons wanting to take seeds, planting material, fruits, etc. outside the country.
2. Procedure & format to obtain certificate/license.
3. Application on prescribed format giving details of material with scientific name which is to be transported.
4. Description and number of packages: Place of origin, means of conveyance and the port of entry (city and country).
5. Supporting documents: Source of purchase/acquisition and disinfestations treatment from competent authority like Zonal Agricultural Officer, Farm Superintendent etc.



## **The Goa Fruit and Ornamental Plant Nurseries (Regulation) Act, 1995. (by online mode)**

### ***1. The following documents are mandatory:***

1. Prescribe format duly completed with relevant details.
2. Registration Certificate/ source of Fruit bearing plants in case not owned/produce
3. Residence Proof: Ration Card/ Aadhar Card
4. Site Plan
5. GST Certificate, only if turnover is above Rs. 20 lakhs
6. Property Documents like 1/14 form, Sale deed/lease deed/ NOC/ POA etc. along with Affidavit/ Self Declaration
7. Company Photographs

A complete file enclosing all the above mentioned documents have to be submitted in the Zonal Agriculture Office where the nursery is located under the said jurisdiction and payment of the requisite fees for nursery license.
