Health Minister Shri Vishwajit Rane confirming death of the lady said that it cannot be called as due to COVID-19 infection as test reports of her samples are still awaited.

The lady complained of respiratory distress, diagnosed with COPD infectie exacerbation and since was shifted to isolation ward to rule out doubts.

She has no travel history of outside Goa," Rane said.
