

Minutes of Meeting of the State Executive Committee held at the Forest Bhavan, on 23rd May, 2020

On 23/05/2020, a meeting of State Executive Committee (SEC) was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary (also Principal Secretary, PWD), Goa and the following other members of the SEC also attended:

1. Shri Puneet Goel, Principal Secretary, Science and Technology
2. Shri S.K. Bhandari, Secretary, Transport
3. Shri Sanjay Kumar, Secretary Revenue, Member Secretary, SEC & SDMA

The SEC was briefed about the reports on Law & Order, Trucks Movement, Relief & Shelters, and Covid Status Report (copy attached). The other officers (as per the list Annexed), also attended the meeting as special invitees.

After deliberation on the current situation, the SEC noted and decided the following:

1. **Status of COVID19:** Secretary Health informed that 573 reports were received for Covid tests (this includes tests done on the samples collected so far of those who were surveyed during the House-to-House survey for SARI/ILI patients), during the last 24 hours, and all were negative except one. The total number of active cases is 39.
2. The SEC discussed the proposed SOP for handling of incoming passengers. Based on the facts shared by the Collectors and Secretary, Health and discussion with others officers present, the SEC decided the following:
 - o Anyone coming to the State shall have to fill a self declaration form giving their contact details and address. Additionally, they would be required to opt for either:
 - i. Compulsory 14-days home quarantine,
 - or
 - ii. Paid testing at the time of arrival.
 - o Any domestic passenger, irrespective of mode of travel, will be screened with Thermal scanners. After screening, anyone with fever or other symptoms shall undergo compulsory Covid testing.
 - o The movement of international passengers will be dealt as per the guidelines issued by the MHA from time to time.
 - o People who opt for home quarantine shall be monitored by the Health workers, as per the existing protocol.
3. Shri Kunal, the Nodal officer, informed that 9652 persons were sent to the UP in six trains yesterday. Today, two trains would leave Goa, one for Jharkhand and another to Orissa.

4. MD, KTCL informed that 151 KTCL buses were operational today. He further added that the KTCL would undertake massive sanitising exercises, including of the private buses. The SEC directed him and the Director (Transport) to take suitable action to prevent overcrowding in KTCL and other private buses.
5. The Nodal Officer for Quarantine facilities informed that a total of 1024 persons (out of them 631 are seafarers) are sheltered in quarantine facilities.
6. Secretary, Port informed that one Sri Lankan ship MT Basra was stuck about 12 nautical miles from Goa coast for the last many days. He has discussed the matter with different authorities and the ship's agent and was informed that the vessel is likely to go to Karwar within a day or two for repair.
7. Secretary, Civil Supply informed that ration distribution is complete for the month of May 2020. For the next month, the department would be using E-POS machines. The government staff deployed for monitoring ration distribution at FPS shops have been relieved.
8. PCE(PWD) informed that the planned shutdown of the Opa treatment plant for pre monsoon repair/maintenance has been completed, and normal water supply has been restored in the affected Talukas, viz. Tiswadi and Ponda. The IGP informed that there was a social media post about non availability of water for six days in Mandrem, Pernem Taluka. The SEC asked the PCE to verify the facts for problem resolution.

Committee also conveyed to all concerned that as per MHA orders, any person violating these containment measures or not complying with the above directions will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action u/s 188 of the IPC.
