CORRIGENDUM TO ADVERTISEMENT NO. 6 YEAR 2020 PUBLISHED ON 17/07/2020

Online applications are invited for the below mentioned posts of Incharge Marine Slipway, by Transfer on Deputation (including Short Term Contract) and Deputy Hydrographic Surveyor, by Transfer on Deputation (including Short Term Contract) in the Captain of Ports Department at Sr. Nos. III. 3 & 4. The Recruitment Rules for the above mentioned posts may be read as below. The last date for filling up the applications is further extended upto 09.10.2020.

Candidates should carefully read the "Instructions" available on Commission's website before filling the application online.

2. In case of non-availability of suitable candidates with the knowledge of Konkani for the posts in professional colleges, Consultants in Directorate of Health Services and highly technical/scientific posts, the Goa Public Service Commission may recommend a candidate if otherwise found fit and this requirement can be relaxed by the Government, on the recommendation of the Goa Public Service Commission, if the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do.

3. Prescribed EQs are minimum & mere possession of same does not entitle the candidates to be called for interview. Where number of applications received is large, the Commission will short list the candidates to be called for interview as mentioned in the "Instructions".

III. CAPTAIN OF PORTS DEPARTMENT

3. Incharge Marine Slipway, by Transfer on Deputation (including Short Term Contract) 1 post

Scale of Pay: Rs. 9,300-34,800+4,200/- (pre-revised) (As per revised pay matrix level 6)

Transfer on Deputation (including short-term contract):

Officers under the Central/State Govts./Union Territories/Public Undertakings e.g. Shipping Companies or Marine Organisations; etc,

(a)(i) holding analogous posts on a regular basis; or (ii) with 5 years regular service in posts in the scale of Rs. 1400-2300 (corresponding pre-revised scale of PB-1 Rs. 5200-20200 + Rs. 2800 G.P. which is in Level 5 of the Pay Matrix) and (b) possessing the educational qualifications and experience laid down for direct recruits i.e.

(i) Degree/Diploma in Mechanical/Marine, or Automobile Engineering of a recognised University or equivalent. (ii) 3 years' experience for degree holders and 5 years' experience for diploma in maintenance/overhauling and repairs of marine/auto diesel engines/hull repair etc. in a reputed Shipyard/Marine Workshop.

Note 1: Qualifications are relaxable, at the discretion of the G.P.S.C. in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2: The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the G.P.S.C. in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes if, at any stage of selection, the G.P.S.C. is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another excadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years).

4. Deputy Hydrographic Surveyor, by Transfer on Deputation (including Short Term Contract) 1 post

Scale of Pay: Rs. 15,600-39,100+5,400/- (pre-revised) (As per revised pay matrix level 10)

Transfer on Deputation (including short-term contract):

Officers under the Central/State Government/Union Territories/University/Recognised Research Institutions/Public Sector Undertakings, Statutory, Semi-Government or Autonomous Organisations.

(a)(i)Holding analogous posts on regular basis; OR (ii) with 5 years service in posts in the scale of Rs. 2000-3500 (corresponding to pre-revised scale of PB 2 Rs. 9300-34800 + Rs. 4200 G.P. which is in Level 6 of the Pay Matrix) or equivalent; OR (iii) with 10 years service in the posts in the scale of Rs. 1640-2900 (corresponding to pre-revised scale of PB 2 Rs. 9300-34800 + Rs. 4200 G. P. which is in Level 6 of the Pay Matrix) or equivalent; and

(b) Possessing the educational qualifications as prescribed for direct recruits i.e.

(i) Licentiate member of the Institution of Surveyors (India) in Sub Div. I (b) Hydrographic Surveying and minimum of 5 years experience in surveying in a recognised Hydrographic Surveying Service as Asst. Hydrographic Surveyor or equivalent, after obtaining Licentiate member.

OR

Should be a Survey Recorder 1st class of the Indian Navy and at least 5 years experience in Surveying in a recognised Hydrographic Surveying Services as Asst. Hydrographic Surveyor or equivalent, after obtaining Survey Recorder 1st class of the Indian Navy.

(Period of deputation, including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately in the same or some other organization/Department of the Central/State Government, shall not exceed 3 years. The departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion).

NOTE: Those candidates who have applied earlier need not apply again.
