1. *Short title and commencement.*— The scheme shall be called “**Modified scheme for Custom Hiring Service in Agriculture**”.

(i) The scheme shall cover all talukas of the State of Goa.

(ii) The scheme shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain in force till it is withdrawn or as amended.

1. *Objectives.*— (i) Promote agricultural mechanization to overcome shortage and high cost of manual labour.

(ii) To encourage optimum tillage through custom service facility.

(iii) Enable completion of agricultural operations in time.

(iv) To bring in mechanization within reach of common farmer.

2. *Eligibility.*— (i) All the farmers in Goa venturing for ploughing/transplanting/ weeding/harvesting shall be eligible for subsidy on hire charges of agricultural machineries.

(ii) Machinery should be hired from Government Departments or Government approved agencies.

3. *Pattern of Assistance.*— (i) 50% subsidy on standard hire charges will be provided to farmers at source while booking agriculture machineries on hire from Department of Agriculture. Whenever a Government approved agencies hire the machine, farmer has to pay full cost of hire charges and thereafter 50% subsidy shall be released to farmer after the work is completed and on due application.

(ii) 50% subsidy on standard hire charges shall also be provided for agriculture machineries hired by following agencies.— (a) Sanjivani Sahakari Sakhar Karkhana Ltd. (b) Command Area Development Authority (CADA). (c) Goa Tillari Irrigation Corporation. (d) Department approved Farmers Club, NGO, Village Agro Service Centre. (e) Co-operative Societies. (f) Department approved individuals hiring out machinery at approved rates. (g) Manufacturing Companies custom hiring centres.

(iii) 60% subsidy for transplanting would be provided in case of collective farming for more than 04 Nos. of farmers having less than 1 hectare area of each individual farmers & combined to do transplanting collectively.

(iv) The present rate of standard hire charges are as shown below:—

- (a) Tractor (30 HP and above) : Rs. 500/hour
- (b) Mini Tractor (Upto 29 HP) : Rs. 200/hour
- (c) Power tiller (Upto 18HP) : Rs. 200/hour
- (d) Paddy combine harvester : Rs. 2000/hour
- (e) Paddy Transplanting :

(a) The subsidy for raising nursery & transplanting will be maximum of Rs. 15,000/- per hectare for individual farmers as shown at 3(i) & 3(ii) in Pattern of Assistance above and subsidy for raising nursery and transplanting will be maximum of Rs. 18,000/- per hectare for collective farming as shown in Pattern of Assistance at 3(iii) above.

(b) Incase of individual farmers, there will be a subsidy cap of maximum 2 hectare area & for collective farming, individuals should be having maximum 1 hectare area. However higher area can be part of collective farming but benefit will be restricted to 1 hectare area only.

(v) The subsidy shall be released based on standard hire charges per hour fixed by Department of Agriculture for each type of machine except for transplanter. The standard hire charges would be fixed by a committee nominated by Director of Agriculture with approval of Finance Department & Government. The committee will determine the cost of hire charges. However in case of transplanter, committee will determine raising of nursery & transplanting cost separately.

(vi) The subsidy for tilling soil shall be provided for cultivation of all crops & shall cover all operations.

(vii) No subsidy shall be provided to the farmer who has been provided with the appropriate machine for ploughing, transplanting, weeding and harvesting.

(viii) Wherever the subsidy is provided at source to the farmers at the time of payment of hire charges by Government, the subsidy will be book adjusted.

4. *Procedure and guidelines for claim of subsidy.*— (a) The agencies who are registered for providing custom hiring to the farmers will have a cap on the number of hours the machine would work in a season/year. The following machines would work as follows:—

- (i) Tractor : 600 Hours per year
- (ii) Mini tractor : 500 Hours per year
- (iii) Power tiller/Mini tiller : 500 Hours per year
- (iv) Transplanting machine : 250 Hours per season (Kharif & Rabi)
- (v) Weeding machine : 250 Hours per season (Kharif & Rabi)
- (vi) Harvesting Machine : 350 Hours per season (Kharif & Rabi)

Any agency willing to do additional hours would be free to do so, however his bill will not be considered for subsidy.

(b) The agency would be given the requisition for carrying out the work by the concerned taluka level officer (i.e. Mechanical Cultivation Officer or Zonal Agricultural Officer) against which the agency will carry out the work of the farmer.

(c) In case of departmental tractors, subsidy to farmers will be provided at source while accepting advance payment towards standard hire charges.

(d) In case of machinery provided by agencies like Sanjivani Sahakari Sakhar Karkhana, Goa Tillari Irrigation Development Corporation, C.A.D.A. etc., subsidy will be paid to the agency if machinery is provided to farmers at subsidised rates.

(e) In case of farmer, subsidy will be reimbursed to the farmer upon receipt of claim from farmer and after verification of work and receipts towards work done.

(f) The farmer shall apply for subsidy within a period of three months from the date of execution of ploughing/harvesting/ /transplanting work.

(g) The formats of self declaration, acknowledgement, letter of authority to be furnished along with claims is enclosed.

(h) Annexures forming Annexure-I & Annexure-II for claiming reimbursement of custom service enclosed.

(i) Annexure-III as format of register to be maintained by the custom service provider to ascertain the number of working hours of machinery per season/year.

5. *Interpretation.*— Issues, if any, arising with regards to interpretation of any clause, word(s), expression(s) or the entire scheme, the decision in this respect shall vest with the Government.

6. *Redressal of grievances and disputes.*— Grievances or disputes, if any, arising out of implementation of the scheme shall be submitted to and decided by the Minister of Agriculture and the decision taken in this respect shall be final and binding on all concerned.

7. *Relaxation.*— The Government shall, with prior consultation with the Finance Department relax any or all conditions specified above to meet the objectives of the scheme.

This Notification shall be effective from immediate effect.

Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojna Kharif Season 2018

Reference is made to the Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare, Department of Agriculture, Co-operation & Farmers' Welfare, Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi letter No. 13015/03/2016-Credit-II dated 23rd February, 2016, regarding the 'Administrative Approval for Implementation of Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojna (PMFBY).

Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojna (PMFBY) is being continued in State at the Cluster of Village Panchayats level through HDFC ERGO GENERAL INSURANCE COMPANY LTD. in North Goa District and SBI GENERAL INSURANCE COMPANY LTD. in South Goa District.

The scheme will be continued during Kharif 2018 season on the following conditions:

1. *Implementing Agency.*— The district wise implementing agency is given in Annexure I.

2. *Risks Covered and Exclusion.*— Following stages of the crop and risks leading to crop loss are covered under the scheme:

(a) *Prevented Sowing/Planting Risk:* Insured area is prevented from sowing/ /planting due to deficit rainfall or adverse seasonal conditions.

(b) *Standing Crop (Sowing to Harvesting):* Comprehensive risk insurance is provided to cover yield losses due to non-preventable risks, viz. Drought, Dry spells, Flood, Inundation, Pests and Diseases, Landslides, Natural Fire and Lightening, Storm, Hailstorm, Cyclone, Typhoon, Tempest, Hurricane and Tornado etc.

(c) *Post-Harvest Losses:* Coverage is available only up to a maximum period of two weeks from harvesting for those crops which are allowed to dry in cut and spread condition in the field after harvesting against specific perils of cyclone and cyclonic rains and unseasonal rains.

(d) *Localized Calamities:* Loss/damage resulting from occurrence of identified localized risks of hailstorm, landslide and inundation affecting isolated farms in the notified area.

(e) *General Exclusions:* Losses arising out of war and nuclear risks, malicious damage and other preventable risks shall be excluded.

Important Conditions/Clauses Applicable for Coverage of Risks:

1. Insurance companies should have received the premium for coverage either from bank, channel partner, insurance intermediary or directly. Any loss in transit due to negligence by these agencies or non-remittance of premium by these agencies, the concerned bank/ /intermediaries shall be liable for payment of claims.

2. In case of any substantial mis-reporting by nodal bank/branch in case of compulsory farmers coverage, the concerned bank only shall be liable for such mis-reporting.

3. Mere sanctioning/disbursement of crop loans and submission of proposals/ /declarations and remittance of premium by farmer/bank, without explicit intent to raise the crop, does not constitute acceptance of risk by insurance company.
