- e. Mode of Payment towards Tender Document Fee(TDF), Tender Processing Fee(TPF), & Earnest Money Deposite(EMD) to be paid online through e-Payment mode via:
 - i) National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT) / Real-Time Gross Settlement RTGS) / Axis Bank Over-the-counter (OTC). Tenderer requires download pre-printed Challan towards credit of ITG available on e-tender website and make its payment through any of their Bank.

Also, name of the Tenderer should be entered in respective cell.

- 2. The intending Tenderer must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he consideres himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
- 3. Information and Instructions for Tenderer posted on website shall form part of bid document.
- 4. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantity of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen in the Divisional Office or downloaded from website https://goaenivida.gov.in.
- 5. Those Tenderer not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on online bidding process as per details available on the website. - 6. The intending bidder must have / obtain a valid class-III digital signature to submit the bid.
- 7. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
- 8. It is the responsibility of the Tenderer to ensure the credit of Tender Document Fees, Tender Processing Fees and EMD into the respective receiving bank accounts of ITG via various mode of payments mentioned above, on or before last any due date and time of tender.
- 9. In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0".
