World Wetlands Day is celebrated every year across the world on 02nd February to commemorate the Convention on Wetlands or the Ramsar Convention which was held on 02nd February 1971 in the city of Ramsar, Iran. For the first time it was celebrated in the year 1997. The theme for World Wetlands Day-2021 is “**Wetlands and Water**”.

On the occasion of ‘World Wetlands Day-2021’, Goa State Wetland Authority (GSA) is organizing following activity and competition.

1. Restoration of water bodies under initiative ‘*Shram Shakti se Jal Samrudhi*’

- Wherein restoration of waterbodies would be taken up with people’s participation and least electro-mechanical intervention (shram daan).
- Local bodies, individuals, Biodiversity Management Committees (BMC), organizations should restore and conserve atleast one water body using traditional methods.
- Proposals may be invited, if felt appropriate by the committee the best proposals will be selected and the funds as well as execution methods will be advised.
- Proposal/entry should submit on or before 20.1.2021 before 5:00pm IST.
- The decision of the committee shall be final and binding.

2. Poster making competition for differently abled student

- Poster should be A1 size (*Approximately 23.39 inches x 33.11 inches*)

- Poster to be hand submitted to GSWA office (On working days) at O/o Goa State Biodiversity Board, 1st Floor Department of Science, Technology and Environment, Opposite Saligao Seminary, Saligao, Bardez – Goa.

- All the entries should reach GSWA office on or before 29.01.2020, 05:00pm IST.
