C I R C U L A R

Sub:- Encroachment on Government land.

This Department received information about some instances of encroachment on the Government land. Such cases are required to be examined and necessary action to be initiated as per the relevant provision of Goa Daman & Diu Land Revenue Code, 1968 and Goa Land (Prohibition on construction Act, 1995(Goa Act No 20 of 1995) without further delay.

In order to check the encroachments on the Government land Dy. Collectors of the respective Talukas/Sub-divisions are responsible and accountable for any encroachment of Government lands in their respective sub-divisions.

To prevent such encroachments, all Dy. Collector are instructed to ensure strict implementation of the provisions of Goa Daman & Diu Land Revenue Code, 1968 and Goa Land (Prohibition on Construction) Act, 1995 (Goa Act No 20 of 1995) directly and through Mamlatdar and submit weekly report to the concerned Collectors.

Any future encroachment of Government Land will lead to severe consequence for the officer concerned for dereliction of duty.
