OFFICE MEMORANDUM

The Office Memorandum No.11013/9/2014-Estt.A-III dated 19/04/2021 issued by Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Personnel & Training, Government of India, New Delhi, regarding preventive measures to contain the spread of Noval Coronavirus (COVID-19) to the Central Government officials.

In order to take preventive measures pertaining to the State Government Employees, it is decided to make it applicable to the Government employees to exempt to mark biometric attendance in Aadhar Based Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) till 15/05/2021 or for further orders, whichever is earlier. However, all the employees are required to mark their attendance in Attendance register, (as done prior to launch of biometric system), during this period.
