CIRCULAR

Sub: NOC from PWD issued for Grant/ Shifting of licence for Wholesale/ retail sale of IMFL, CL and Foreign Liquor.

Excise Department grants licence for wholesale/ retail sale of IMFL, CL and Foreign Liquor as required under the Goa Excise Duty Act & Rules, 1964 on fulfillment of various requirements by the applicant. One such mandatory requirement is No Objection Certificate issued by various departments such as Police Department, Health Department, Public Works Department and Local Bodies such as Municipal Council/ Municipal Corporation/ Village Panchayat.

Currently, the Excise Inspector incharge of Excise Stations makes a letter to the concerned Department as per the type of application for grant and shifting of liquor licence, for issue of NOC.


The Notification bearing No. 2/10/2012-Fin(R&C)/Part II/653 dated 4.08.2016 of Government of Goa, wherein it is directed that, No licence shall be granted to an applicant for sale of liquor, if the premises in which he/she proposes to open liquor shop is located on a National Highway; and memorandum No. CE/PA/2016-2017/75, dated.03/01/2017 this Office is hereby directed to obtain a Certificate from the Highway Authority in view of Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 15/12/2016.

In order to streamline and simplify the procedures; this department has decided to discontinue the practice of issuing letter from the Excise Inspector to the concerned departments, therefore, it is requested to issue the NOC to the applicant as per the requirement mentioned below on the basis of the online application for generated for grant/ shifting of liquor licence:

"1. Whether the proposed premises is situated within a distance of 220 mts of the outer edge of National Highway/ State Highway or of a service lane along the Highway.

2. *Whether the proposed premises is directly accessible from a National Highway/ State Highway.*
3. *Whether the proposed premises is visible from a National Highway/ State Highway."*
