C I R C U L A R

Attention of all the members of the Travel and Trade are invited to the Circular issued by the Directorate of Health service, National Vector Borne Diseases control Programme under signature of the Chief Secretary of Goa dated 19.07.2011.

The prevention/control of Vector Borne Diseases namely Malaria, Filariasis, Dengue, Chikungunya and Japanese Encephalitis are considered as everybody's concerned and all need to participate in the programme to prevent and control this disease.

You are therefore directed to appoint the Nodal Officer/Person in your organization who shall visit various sites at least once a week to identify the breeding sites and to take necessary action accordingly. The appointed person shall have to check leads of over head water tanks, water leakages leading to water accumulation, checking of unwanted/discarded containers etc. He may consult the Health Personnel of that area for guidance as situation demands.

This may be done on fore-footing to avoid any untoward situation during this monsoon season. The Action Taken and compliance on the above may be furnished to the Directorate of Health Services.
