

UNION HOME MINISTER ASK SCIENCE STREAM STUDENTS TO JOIN FORENSIC COLLEGE

Union Minister FOR Home Affairs and Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah [today](#) performed 'Bhoomi Pujan and Shilanyas' of National Forensic Sciences University (NFSU)'s permanent Campus at Dharbandora in South Goa in the distinguished presence of Chief Minister, Dr. Pramod Sawant, Minister of State for Tourism and Ports, Shipping and Water Way, Government of India, Shri Shripad Yesso Naik, Deputy Chief Minister, Shri Chandrakant (Babu) Kavlekar, Home Secretary, Rajya Sabha MP Shri Vinay Tendulkar, PWD Minister Deepak Pauskar, Home Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, Shri Ajay Kumar Bhalla, Principal Secretary Finance, Government of Goa Shri Punit Kumar Goel.

Speaking after performing 'Bhoomi Pujan and Shilanyas' the Union Minister of Home Affairs and Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah said Goa is well known for seafarers all over world. Similarly after start of Forensic College, Goa would provide most forensic scientists to the Country which is facing shortage of human resource in the forensic field. Shri Shah declared that the classes of Forensic College also started from [today](#) at Curti transit Premises with five different courses. Union Minister further said that after ten years Goa will be known for producing maximum number of Forensic Scientists. He further urged science stream students to join forensic college for gainful employment in the field. The state will also be known for producing maximum number of Forensic scientists and professionals who will help maintain law and order situation in the country. He also urged NFSU to commence courses related to tourism, drug and narcotics, coastal policing etc.

Speaking further Shri Amit Shah said Union Government intends to promote tourism in Goa in big way. Goa is most preferred tourism destination in the world. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has taken decision to allow charter aeroplanes in Goa from [October 15](#). Similarly, to boost tourism five lakh tourist will be provided with free visa without charging fees for them. Shri Shah also said in order to encourage tourism Rs 10 lakh loan will be provided to people connected with tourism related activities, similarly loan of Rs 1 lakh to tourist guides to boost tourism.

The Home Minister said former Defence Minister and former Chief Minister of Goa late Manohar Parrikar will always be remembered and not never be forgotten for his contribution towards country for two main reasons one for launching surgical strike that showed the India's ability to the world and

second for one rank one pension scheme for Indian soldiers due to which the soldiers are discharge tension free duties on border without any worry about future of their family members.

Shri Sahah lauded the state for all round development and said it was possible due to political stability. Chief Minister Sawant projected the state as an Education Hub and Innovation Center due to the presence of several institutes of national repute in Goa including NCAOR, National Institute of AYUSH, GIM, IIT, NIT etc.

Speaking on the occasion Chief Minister Dr. Pramod Sawant expressed happiness over the various national level education institutions being set up in the state and mentioned that such universities provides good opportunities to the people across state. However since 2014 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi helped achieve remarkable development in Goa in various sectors and **today** with Foundation stone for forensic university it is on the path of becoming educational hub. It is the University in Goa after Gujarat and Tripura. This university would be one step ahead towards progress of Dharbandora Taluka, he added.
