

## **UNION HOME MINISTER SHRI SHAH TO PERFORM BHOOMI PUJAN OF NFSU'S GOA CAMPUS TOMORROW**

Punya Salila Srivastava, NFSU's Vice-Chancellor, Dr. J.M. Vyas and other dignitaries of different sectors will grace the occasion.

National Forensic Sciences University (NFSU) is the first and only Forensic Sciences University in the world. Dr. J.M. Vyas is the founder Vice-Chancellor of this unique and highly specialized Forensic Sciences University.

Union Minister of Home Affairs and Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah will perform the 'Bhoomi Pujan and Shilanyas' at the permanent campus land of 50 acres which is allotted to NFSU by Government of Goa at Dharbandora in South Goa. After the 'Bhoomi Pujan and Shilanyas', Shri Amit Shah and Chief Minister of Goa Shri Dr. Pramod Sawant and other dignitaries will address the gathering. Thereafter, Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah will inaugurate the transit campus of NFSU at Curti – Ponda in Goa.

On the special occasion of "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav" and "60 years of Goa Liberation", the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India has started the branch of National Forensic Sciences University in the State of Goa. This campus will also help to prevent, reduce, and detect the crime through Forensic Science and allied subjects. So that many issues related to law and order of the public at large can be resolved expeditiously and satisfactorily and thereby speeding up the justice delivery system. The University has established a new campus with an aim of imparting professional forensic education, research and development, consultancy, training etc. in the areas of Forensic Science and allied subjects.

National Forensic Sciences University has started four courses from this academic year 2021-22 at Goa Campus. Under which five year BSc-MSc Forensic Science, three courses of two years namely MSc Forensic Science, MSc Digital Forensics and Information Security, and MSc Cyber Security.
