ORDER

WHEREAS the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India vide their O.M No.25022/24/2020-F.V/F.1 dated 07/10/2021 have approved that all foreign nationals intending to visit India for tourism purposes will be allowed to enter into India on e-tourist visa/Tourist visa through Chartered flights (for group tourism only) from October 15, 2021; and all individual foreign nationals intending to visit India for tourism purposes will be allowed to enter into India on e-Tourist visa/Tourist visa w.e.f. 15.11.2021;

AND WHEREAS, considering this, it is necessary to make compulsory testing of all the international passengers by Rapid RT-PCR Tests at the Goa Airport or Sea Port.

NOW, THEREFORE, Government has approved for **capping of Rapid RT-PCR Test @ ₹1,500/- per test inclusive of all taxes, until further review.**
