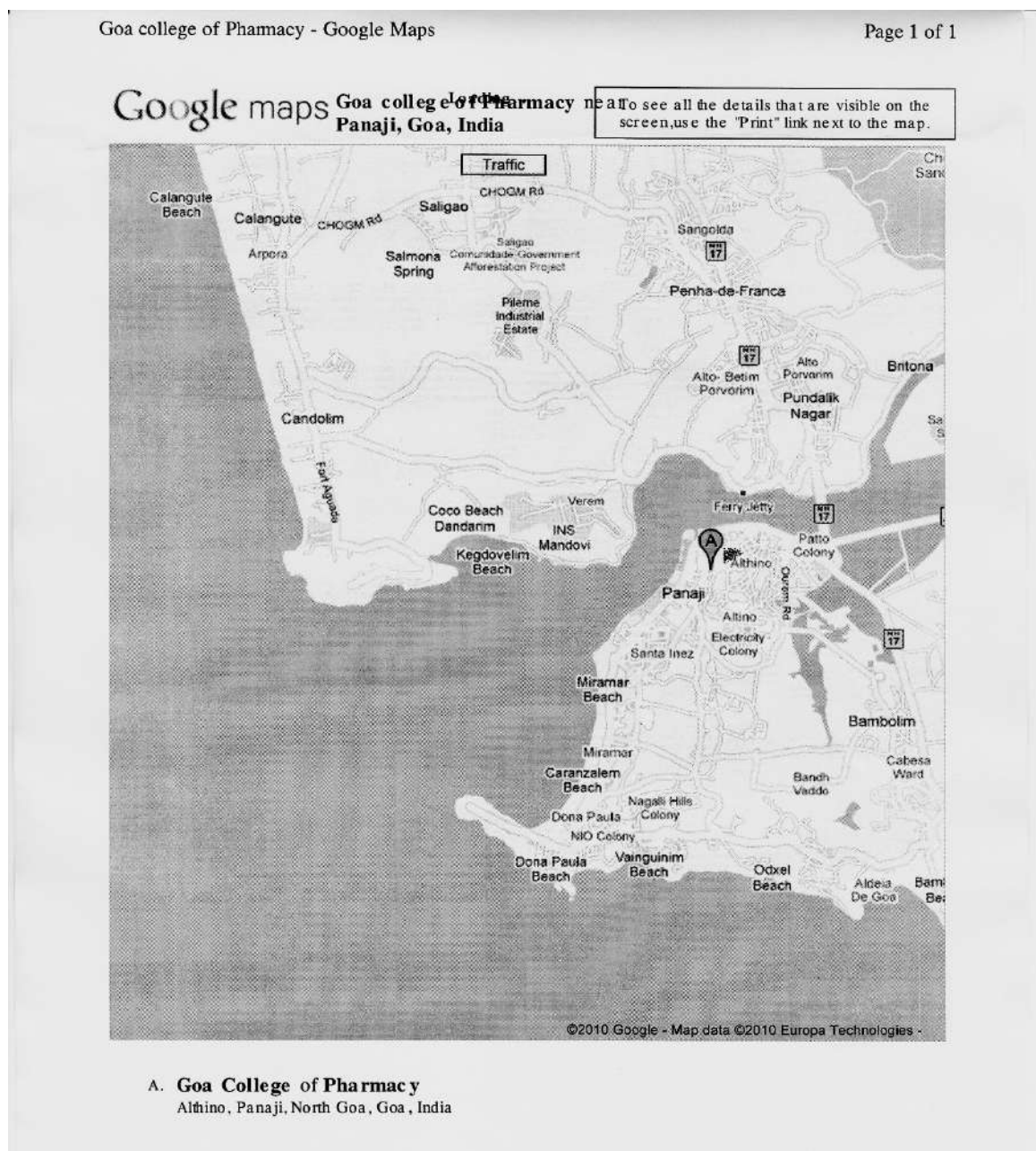

Organizational Chart of the Department:

Goa College of Pharmacy, established in the year 1963 under the aegis of Govt. of Goa, is the pioneer institution imparting quality education to the students. It was upgraded from the Old Portuguese medical school known as Escola Medica de Goa, pharmacy course in Escola Medico de Cirurgica de Goa, to a full-fledged Degree Course of Bachelor of Pharmacy under the University of Bombay, followed by Diploma in Pharmacy in 1966 and Master's Degree in Pharmacy by Research in the year 1970.

This institution, having a rich history of being one of the oldest pharmacy training institutions since the 1870's during Portuguese era, has been the pioneer institute in the field of pharmacy education after having a separate identity as Goa College of Pharmacy under the aegis of Govt. of Goa since 1963. Goa College of Pharmacy serving the Goan public for 57 years as the government institution has grown from strength to strength in terms of producing pharmacy professionals with apt theoretical knowledge and practical skills to cater to the needs of various pharmaceutical industries, research centres, community pharmacies, hospitals and regulation (FDA) in addition to academics.

Goa College of Pharmacy has been producing pharmacists with a vowed objective of facilitating the manufacture of quality medicines and providing an apt "pharmaceutical care" to the people of the state of Goa. To achieve this objective the college in addition to imparting quality education to the students in programs like D. Pharm, B, Pharm and M. Pharm, from the year 2014-15, college has commenced Ph.D. programs in various disciplines to actively be engaged in advanced research activities leading to contribute better health care.

College has been recognised as a centre for Ph.D. in Pharmacy by Goa University where eight Ph.D. guides are recognised. Currently, 16 research scholars are pursuing their Ph.D. of which 5 are full time and the rest being faculty members of both the pharmacy colleges as part time research scholars. Two research scholars have already been awarded the Ph.D. degree, while one has submitted the thesis to the university.

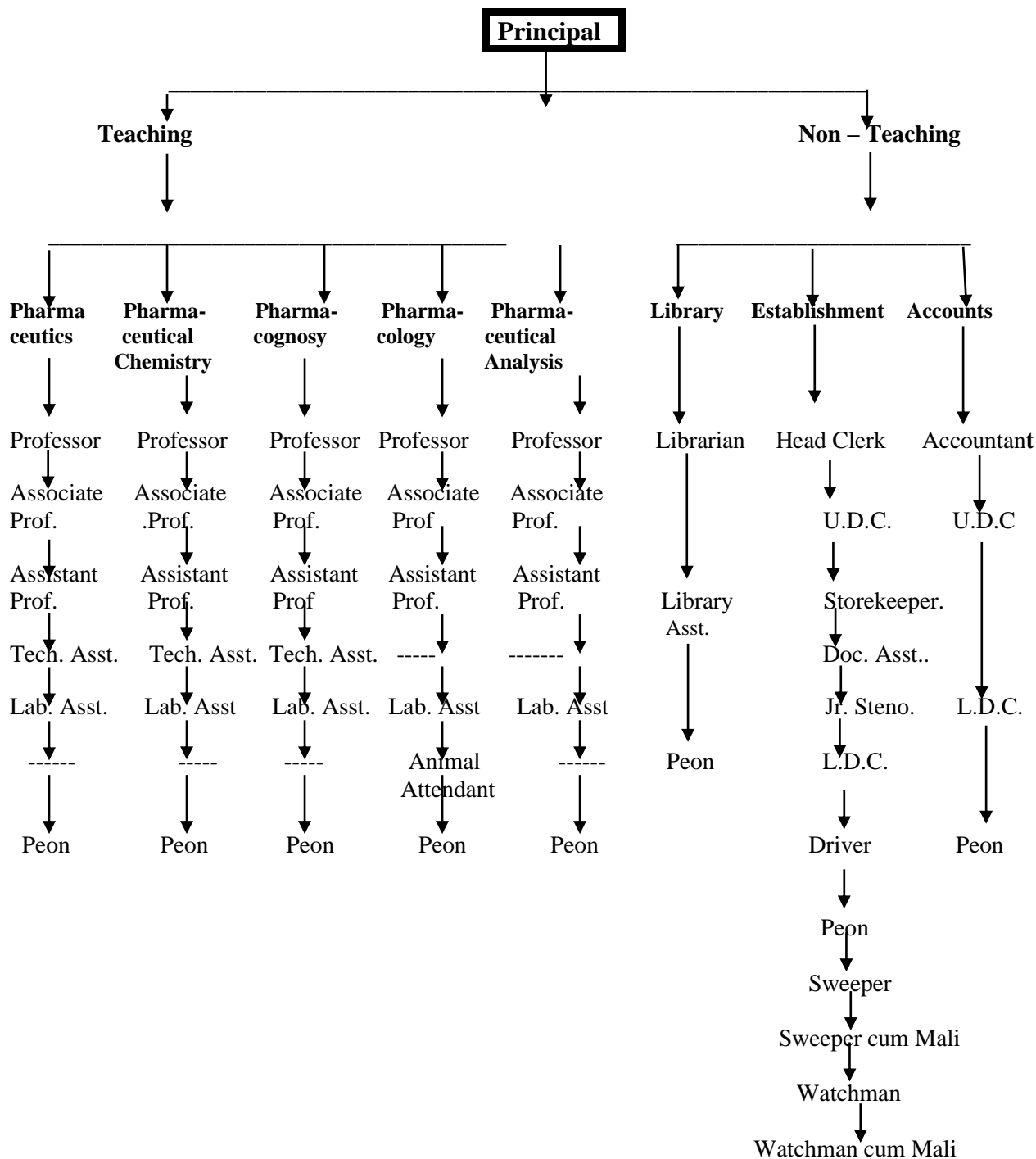
The college is approved by Pharmacy Council of India, All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi and affiliated to Goa University. The college has been ranked by National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) among the top 60 institutions for the years 2016-2021.

Goa College of Pharmacy is governed by government of Goa. The government is benevolent for providing research facilities and promotion of research in the institute. The institute is headed by seasoned principal who is having 30 years of experience as academician and researcher. The institute is having well qualified and competent faculty members in each

discipline, which enhances interdisciplinary contribution in research. Along with the qualified faculty members, the institute is having various sophisticated instruments under each discipline and laboratories dedicated for quality research work. The institute is located in close proximity of various pharmaceutical industries, enabling meaningful collaborative research work.

The Institution is headed by the Principal. There are five Departments Viz. Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmacognosy, Pharmacology and Pharmaceutical Analysis. Each Department has a Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor with Technical Assistant, Laboratory Assistant and Peon to assist them in the laboratory work.
