

- i) Encourage children of Class IX and above to watch the programme on TV Channels / Digital media including <http://education.gov.in> and YouTube.com / MyGov.in from 11.00 AM onwards on 1st April 2022.
- ii) Necessary arrangements are to be made in your school so that all the students from Class IX, X, XI and XII can view / hear the telecast/broadcast.
- iii) This information may be widely disseminated through your office school website, social media groups etc.
- iv) Poster or Banner regarding the same may be displaced on the School Notice Board

You are directed to submit the number of the students / teachers / Parents of your schools who have viewed / heard the telecast of the PPC2022 to SCERT -Goa **through the below mentioned Google Form only on 1st April 2022 by 03.00 PM positively:**

SOP for uploading photos of “PPC 2022” by School on MyGov portal

PART A: Click a group photo along with the students (Watching PPC 2022 PM Event)
(Assisted by School officers)

1. Make sure the photo clarity is good and appropriate.
2. With each entry you are allowed to upload a maximum 5 Photos with a size limit of photos not exceeding 10 MB. (2 MB size of each photo)

PART B: Data entry of Photos with MyGov

1. Click on the link <https://www.mygov.in/ppc-2022>
2. Click on Upload Photo section
3. Login on MyGovAuth
4. Enter the details as follows
 - 4.1 Name (mandatory)
 - 4.2 Email Id
 - 4.3 Mobile Number (mandatory)
 - 4.4 UDISE code of school
 - 4.5 Name of School (mandatory)
 - 4.6 School State (mandatory)
 - 4.7 School District (mandatory)
 - 4.8 Number of students watching the event (mandatory)
 - 4.9 Upload Photo – Max 5 with total size not exceeding 10 MB (2 MB per image)

Important: At least one image is mandatory.

5. Click on submit, a popup will appear with the text “Data entered successfully”.

Note: Maximum 3 entries are allowed per UDISE code/School is permitted for data entry in PPC 2022.
