It has been observed that a number of proposals regarding medical reimbursement claim submitted by the Government employees are for the treatment availed in non-recognised/recognised hospitals and the reasons given are always not genuine. The treatment in such cases are many times available in Government Hospitals viz. Goa Medical College, Asilo Hospital and Hospicio Hospital.

Against this background, it is considered necessary to issue fresh instructions as under:—

1. Unless and until the patient is referred to G.M.C./Government Hospitals and unless it is certified by respective Government Hospitals stating that such facilities are not available in that Hospital or in Goa Medical College only in such cases the Medical Reimbursement claim have to be recommended for consideration of the Government.

2. In case of an emergency and treatment is taken in any private recognised/unrecognized hospitals, in such an event Goa Medical College should justify and certify that the genuine emergency situation existed

and that reference to GMC or any other Government Hospital was not possible due to emergency and even in such cases certificate of the GMC to be taken within 72 hours of such emergent treatment.

3. All the Heads of Departments/Offices and Secretaries to Government are advised to go through these instructions carefully and also bring these to the notice of the employees working under their Administrative control, for strict compliance with effect from date of publication in the Official Gazette.

4. The O.M. shall also be applicable to the Goa Freedom Fighters since they are treated at par with the Government servants for the purpose of medical reimbursement/emergent treatment.

Whereas certain draft rules which the Government of Goa proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 26, 28, 38, 65, 95, 96, 107, 111, 138, 159, 176, 211, 212 and 213 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf so as to amend the Goa Motor Vehicles Rules, 1991 were published as required under section 212 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby within 15 days from the date of publication of the said Notification in the Official Gazette.

And whereas the said Gazette was made available to the public on 12-5-2010.

And whereas the objections and suggestions received from the public on the said draft rules have been considered by the Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 26, 28, 38, 65, 95, 96, 107, 111, 138, 159, 176, 211, 212 and 213 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to amend the Goa Motor Vehicles Rules, 1991, as follows, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Rules, 2010.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of rule 76.*— In rule 76 of the principal Rules,—

(i) in sub-rule (1),—

(a) for the figure “150”, the figure “1,000” shall be substituted for All Goa Tourist Taxi;

for the figure “150”, the figure “5,000” shall be substituted for All India Tourist Taxi;

for the figure “300”, the figure “4,000” shall be substituted for All Goa Tourist Buses;

for the figure “300”, the figure “5,000” shall be substituted for All India Tourist Buses;

for the figure “300”, the figure “2,000” shall be substituted for All Goa Maxi Cabs;

for the figure “300”, the figure “3,000” shall be substituted for All India Maxi Cabs;

for the figure “300”, the figure “1,500” shall be substituted for Stage Carriage Permit;

for the figure “150”, the figure “500” shall be substituted for Yellow/Black Taxi;

for the figure “70”, the figure “300” shall be substituted for Yellow/Black Autorickshaw;

for the figure “70”, the figure “150” shall be substituted for Yellow/Black Motorcycle.

Scheme of scholarship to ST students pursuing Home Nursing Courses

1. *Object.*— The objective of the Scheme is to provide financial assistance to the poor and meritorious students belonging to Scheduled Tribe in order to enable them to pursue Home Nursing courses.

2. *Scope.*— These scholarships are available for studies in India only and will be awarded to the students belonging to ST through the Directorate of Tribal Welfare of the Government of Goa.

3. *Conditions for Scholarship.*— (i) The scholarship will be given to pursue the following courses from an institution recognized by the State/Central Government.

(a) Certificate Course in Home Nursing courses of duration of at least six months.

(b) Diploma in Home Nursing Courses of duration twelve months or more.

(c) Degree in nursing of duration three years.

(d) Health Worker Course of duration one year.

The scholarship shall consist of compulsory non-refundable fees (other than refundable deposits) and Maintenance allowance.

(ii) Students belonging to ST communities who get admission in an institution recognized by the State/Central Government to pursue above mentioned Home Nursing courses, shall be eligible for the scholarship.

(iii) The scholarship shall be awarded to the regular student who is born in Goa and domiciled in Goa for at least 15 years.

(iv) A scholarship holder under this Scheme shall not avail any other scholarship/stipend for pursuing the same course.

(v) The annual income of the parent or guardian of student should not exceed Rs. 1.50 lakhs from all sources.

(vi) The application from the students duly recommended by the Head of Institution shall be received in the Directorate of Tribal Welfare.

(vii) Scholarship will not be paid during internship/housemanship or for a practical training if the student is in receipt of some remuneration during the internship period or some allowance/stipend during the practical training.

4. *Other Conditions for the Award.*— (i) The scholarship is dependent on the satisfactory progress and conduct of the scholar. If it is reported by the Head of the Institution at any time that a scholar has by reasons of his/her own act of default or failed to make satisfactory progress or has been guilty of misconduct such as resorting to or participating in strikes, irregularity in attendance without the permission of the authorities concerned etc., the authority or changes the Institution of study, without prior

permission of State Government. The Head of the Institution shall report such cases to them and stop payment of the scholarship amount. The amount already paid may also be recovered at the discretion of the State Government.

(ii) A scholar is liable to refund the scholarship amount at the discretion of the State Government, if during the course of the studies for which the scholarship has been awarded, is discontinued by him/her.

(iii) The regulations can be changed at anytime at the discretion of the Government of Goa.

5. *Procedure for applying.*— An application for scholarship should comprise.

(a) One copy of the application for scholarship in the prescribed form.

(b) One copy of the passport size photograph with signatures of the student thereon.

(c) An attested copy of Caste Certificate/Social Status Certificate issued by the Deputy Collector.

(d) One attested copy of certificates, diploma, degree etc., in respect of all examinations passed.

(e) An income certificate issued by competent authority showing annual income of the parents/guardians from all sources. Employed parents/guardians may submit income certificate from their employer.

(f) Birth Certificate.

(g) Domiciled Certificate or Residence Certificate issued by competent authority.

(g) Receipt of fees paid to the institution (in original).

(h) Copy of Bank Pass book.

6. *Rate of Scholarship.*—

Rate of scholarship will be as under:

In addition to above Scholarship/Maintenance allowance; a onetime additional amount shall also be provided to the eligible students towards the expenditure to be incurred on Books, Uniform, Stationery etc., as shown below:

7. *Relaxation and Interpretation.*— The Government through Director of Tribal Welfare shall relax/interpret any of the clauses/condition in the Scheme and the decision of the Directors shall be final and binding on all parties.
