JUDGMENT

(Delivered on 6th day of August of the year 2010)

By this order, I propose to dispose of the appeal filed by the above named appellant against the order dated 1-6-1998 passed by the Dy. Collector.

The brief facts of this case are as under:

- The Applicant has filed an application for deletion for the name of the Opponents from Survey No. 46/1 and 46/4 of Village Kakoda of Quepem Taluka.

- The Applicant states that there is D.C. bearing No. 911/Cacora was pending before the Mamlatdar of Records of Rights at Margao wherein bring all the heirs of Olga D'Costa and the matter was kept pending on the submission of the Adv.
- For the Applicant Olga D'Costa however, he has not preferred an appeal but filed the above application under Section 103 of Land Revenue Code for deleting the name of the Opponents/ Respondents.
- It is submitted that said case no notice is served to this Attorney through Administrator of Comunidade but clandestinely issued notice to the President of Cacora who remained absent as such Order is passed on 15th June, 2010 for deleting the name of the Opponents. The Order passed is totally bad which can be urged at the time of hearing.
- The above fact of the said order came to the knowledge of the Attorney through the Component Shri Devendra Sawant thereafter made enquiry and filed this application.

The case of the appellant is as under:

The aforesaid appeal has been disposed of by Order dated 1-6-1998 remanding the matter to the A. K. for Records of Rights for fresh disposal, after setting aside the Order of A. K dated 31-5-1989.

That after the remand of the D.C. No. 911/Cacora was taken up for hearing after the applicant made representation that despite the Order of

Dy. Collector dated 1-6-1998, no date has been fixed for hearing of the aforesaid D.C. for a long time. That the matter is still pending before the Inspector of Survey and Land Records, at Margao, for decision on L. R.s of the deceased applicant to be brought on record and the next date for hearing was on 13-11-2009.

That surprisingly, it was noticed that from several survey numbers involved in D.C. No. 911/Cacora, Survey No. 46/1 has been promulgated when the dispute is still pending decision in the aforesaid case. That the land under Survey No. 46/1 and 46/4 is private property, part of which has been sold to various persons including 1. Smt. Flory Diniz, 2. Richard Rodrigues, 3. Ladin Colaco, 4. Alecina Fernandes and others, more than 25 years back and the said purchasers have done development in their respective plots with fresh cultivation, construction of Farm houses, digging of the wells for irrigation, fencing, etc., spending lakhs of Rupees and they are in possession and enjoyment of their respective plots.

It is further the case of the appellant that there appears some mischief played by someone in the Office of the Inspector of Survey and Land Records to promulgate the said Survey No. 46/1 and 46/4 during the pendency of the Disputed Case No. 911/Cacora without the knowledge of the Appellants (Legal Representative of the Original Applicant) and as such, an enquiry has to be conducted to find out who is responsible for promulgating the said Survey number during the pendency of the Disputed Case and without notice to the parties.

That in the meanwhile, since the implication of promulgation are very serious to the interest of the respective owners and since Comunidade of Cacora is not the owner of the land and since the Management of the Comunidade is very much suspicious, the promulgation of Survey No. 46/1 and 46/4 of Cacora village should be denotified immediately, after notice to the respondents, as has been done in many cases of this nature, pending inquiry into the mischief played by someone in the Office of Survey and Land Records.

Accordingly notice was issued to all the parties.

On the date of hearing, none remained present on behalf of the respondent as such the application was heard and allowed. However, on the same date,

Advocate for the Respondent No. 2 came late and filed application to set aside the said order. The Respondent No. 2 also filed reply which is as under:

The respondent submitted that there was a D.C. bearing No. 911/Cacora pending before the Mamlatdar of Records of Right at Margao wherein the Ld. Mamlatdar of Records of Rights has passed an Misc. Order to bring all the legal heirs of Olga D'Costa and the matter was kept pending on the submission of the Advocate for the Applicant Olga D'Costa, however he has not preferred any appeal but filed the above application under Section 103 of LRC for the deletion of the name of the Opponents/Respondents. That no notice was served to their Attorney through Administrator of Comunidade, but clandestinely issued notice to the President of Comunidade of Cacora who remained absent as such the Order passed on 15th June, 2010 for deleting the name of the Opponents. That the order passed is totally bad which can be urged at the time of hearing. That the fact of the said order came to the knowledge of the Attorney through the Component Shri Devendra Sawant and therefore prayed that the order passed on 15-6-2010 be set aside.

Accordingly the said order dated 15-6-2010 was set aside and treated as withdrawn. Both the parties were directed to argue the matter on the next date of hearing. However, on the subsequent dates of hearing, none remained present on behalf of Respondent No. 2. The Power of Attorney of Respondent No. 1 remained present. Opportunity was given to file written arguments if any.

Thereafter since none remained present on behalf of Respondent No. 2, the matter was ordered to proceed ex parte against the Respondent No. 2. I have perused the record and heard and I am convinced that the appellants were not heard in the matter as their L. Rs are not brought on record which is required to be done by the Trial Court.

ORDER

The order passed for promulgation of Survey No. 46/1 and 46/4 of village Cacora of Quepem taluka stands denotified. The same is ordered to be published on the Official Gazette by the Inspector of Land Survey, Fatorda, Margao who will thereafter hear the parties and decide the same as expeditiously as possible.
