New Delhi, the 29th September, 2010

S.O. 2361(E).— In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955), the Central Government hereby makes the following Order further to amend the Removal of (Licensing Requirements, Stock Limits and Movement Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs Order, 2002, namely:—

1. (1) This order may be called the Removal of (Licensing Requirements, Stock Limits and Movement Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs (Amendment) Order, 2010.

(2) It shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 2010.

2. The provisions of the Removal of (Licensing Requirements, Stock Limits and Movement Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs Order, 2002 (hereinafter referred to as the said Order) except clauses 5 and 6, shall not apply to—

(i) pulses, paddy and rice for a further period up to 30th September, 2011,

(ii) edible oils and edible oilseeds for a further period up to 31st March, 2011,

(iii) sugar for a further period up to 31st December, 2010.

in respect of the purchase, movement, sale, supply, distribution or storage for sale of these commodities.

3. Nothing contained in the said Order, as amended by this Order, shall affect the transport, distribution or disposal of these commodities to places outside the State nor shall it be applicable to import of these commodities:

Provided that the Central Government or the State Government may direct the importers to

declare the receipts of stocks of these commodities and stocks retained by them.

Explanation.— If a wholesaler or retailer or dealer is able to demonstrate that part of his stocks in respect of pulses, paddy, rice, edible oils and edible oilseeds are sourced from imports, then they shall be excluded for the purpose of calculation of stock limits.

4. All other provisions of the said Order shall continue to remain in force even during the period specified in clause 2 of this Order.

S.O. 3249(E).— In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955), the Central Government hereby makes the following Order further to amend the Removal of (Licensing Requirements, Stock Limits and Movement Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs Order, 2002, namely:—

1. (1) This order may be called the Removal of (Licensing Requirements, Stock Limits and

Movements Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs (Seventh Amendment) Order, 2009.

(2) It shall come into force on the 9th day of January, 2010.

2. The words and expressions used in respect of purchase, movement, sale, supply, distribution or storage for sale in the Removal of (Licensing Requirements, Stock Limits and Movement Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs Order, 2002 shall be kept in abeyance for commodity, namely, sugar for a further period upto 30th September, 2010 or further orders, whichever is earlier.

3. Nothing contained in this Order shall affect the transport, distribution or disposal of sugar to places outside the State nor shall it be applicable to import of this commodity:

Provided that the Central Government or State Governments may direct the importers to declare the receipts of stocks of sugar and stocks retained by them.

4. All other provisions of the Removal of (Licensing Requirements, Stock Limits and Movement Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs Order, 2002 shall continue to remain in force even during the period mentioned in clause 2 above.

A Scheme for Financial Assistance to be extended to Higher Education/Technical Education in Professional Institutions of repute in India, has been duly approved by the Government of Goa and taken up for notification to the public.

Scheme for Financial Assistance for Higher Education/Technical Education in Professional Institutions of Repute in India

1. *Objective of the Scheme*.— In recent years Goa has witnessed a sizeable good number of students pursuing their studies in national institutions of repute such as Indian Institute of Technology, Indian Institute of Management, Birla Institute of Technology, etc. Quite often it is observed that these meritorious students find it difficult to meet the expenses involved in pursuing their studies in these institutions. The basic objective of this Scheme is therefore, to recognize the merit of such students in general and to provide deserving students financial assistance to continue with their academic pursuits.

2. *Details of the Scheme*.— 2.1. The Scheme envisages the selection of all such meritorious students who have sought admissions in the institutions of national repute.

2.2. The Scheme lays down the procedure to be followed for the selection of such meritorious students.

2.3. The Scheme will be managed by the Directorate of Higher Education through "HIGHER EDUCATION PROMOTION

FUND(HEPF)" that has been established by the Government for grant of Interest Free Loan, Goa Scholars Scholarship etc., to eligible candidates.

3. *Eligibility for providing Financial Assistance.*— 3.1. Any student seeking financial assistance under the Scheme should have been born in Goa and domiciled in Goa for at least fifteen years.

3.2. He/She has passed Std. Xth and Std. XIIth examination from any of the institutions located in Goa as regular students.

3.3. He/She must be below the age of twenty-two years on the date of application.

3.4. The benefit of the Scheme shall not be available to those whose family income exceeds Rs. 10.00 lakhs per annum. For subsequent continuation of the financial assistance (renewal cases); the family income should not exceed Rs. 4.50 lakhs per annum.

3.5. He/She must have obtained admission in any of the following set of institutions:

- (a) Any of the IITs in India.
- (b) Any of the IIMs in India.
- (c) Any of the BITs in India.

3.6. The Scheme shall come into operation from academic year 2010-11. However, those of the students who are already enrolled in the institution above and are studying in IInd, IIIrd or IVth year shall also be entitled to receive scholarship from the date of applicability of the Scheme on the same terms and conditions.

4. *Special provision for SC/ST Students.*— Any of the SC/ST students seeking admissions in the Institutions mentioned above, shall be entitled to receive 50% of financial assistance more than that of the General Candidates except for item No. 5.1(2).

5. *Amount of Scholarship.*— 5.1. The amount of Financial Assistance provided to the

eligible students shall consist of the following components:

(1) Refund of fees paid to the institution subject to a maximum of Rs. 1.00 lakh or actual fees, whichever is less.

(2) A one time grant for purchase of one laptop subject to a maximum of Rs. 50,000/- or actual, whichever is less.

(3) An amount of Rs. 15,000/- per annum towards purchase of books, stationery, equipments, etc.

(4) Maintenance allowance consisting of hotel fees and mess charges @ Rs. 2,000/- per month or actual, whichever is less.

6. *Application procedure and calendar.*— Applications under the Scheme shall be called from eligible students in the prescribed format on or before 20th June every year. The selection procedure shall be complete before 30th June of that year. Applications received beyond the stipulated dates shall not be considered.

The Scheme would be managed by the DIRECTORATE OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

7. *Renewal of Scholarship.*— The scholarship shall be continued in subsequent years only if the students passes the examination conducted by the concerned institutions with not less than 60% of marks or equivalent grade. Concerned students shall communicate to the Directorate of Higher Education in writing about their performance in the qualifying exam.

8. Any student who is the recipient of financial assistance under this Scheme shall not be entitled to receive benefits under any other scholarship of Government of Goa.
