

STRICT ACTION AGAINST MISUSERS OF NULLHAS : WRD MINISTER

Minister for Water Resources, Shri Subhash Shirodkar has appealed to the general public not to throw garbage in Nullahs. Maintain the natural beauty of the State, he said and warned that strict action will be initiated against those who misuse the Nullahs in the State.

Additional pipeline to Kushavati to Davorlim and Davorlim to Verna are the two projects WRD Minister intends to take up on priority in order to solve the scarcity of water in these areas, he mentioned.

Shri. Shirodkar today visited Verna Industrial Estate along with Shri Aleixo Reginald Laurencio, Chairman, IDC and WRD Officers. He visited two plants in Verna namely IFB and CIPLA and discussed the various issues pertaining to water supply.

Shri Shirodkar expressed satisfaction over the on going water harvesting projects at some of the plants at Verna Industrial Estate, which he said is highly commendable. More plants should come forward and follow such practices in order to overcome the shortage of water, he added.

Speaking further, Shri Shirodkar mentioned about the water harvesting process and said this is one of the beautiful process of self sustenance. He said Natural Resources should be preserved and can be used for daily use.

Replying to media about scarcity of water WRD Minister said, his main objective to visit Verna Industrial Estate site is to ascertain and learn the reasons of shortages, which will be taken care off after discussing with the HODs of the Departments, the Minister added.
