#### Introduction

Achieving ambitious targets requires systematic and strategic enhancement of production and productivity, infusion of technology, quality improvement of seed and feed, value addition, species diversification and an enabling regulatory framework that would facilitate the penetration of fisheries activities deeper into the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ).

### **Other Services**

### 1) Kisan Credit Card (KCC)

In the budget 2018-19 the Union Government had announced their decision to extend the facilities of Kisan Credit Card (KCC) to Fishermen/ Fish farmers and Animal Husbandry farmers to help them to meet their working capital requirements.

**Purpose:** The KCC facility will meet the short term credit requirements of rearing of animals, birds, fish, shrimps, other aquatic organisms, capture of fish etc.

**Beneficiary:** The fishermen/ fish farmer who own or lease registered fishing vessel/boat, possesses necessary fishing license/permission for fishing in estuary and sea, fish farming/mariculture activities in estuaries and open sea and any other State specific fisheries and allied activities.

**Status:** The eligible fishermen/ fish farmer should apply to the respective Bank for availing the KCC facility.

### 3) Registration of Fish Sellers and Fish Agents

In order to bring all the fish agents and fish vendors under the ambient of the Fisheries Department, the Department has started registration of fish sellers and fish agents. This will help the department to identify/recognized the fishermen from different localities/communities and the department could maintain the database of all fishermen all over the State. This will also allow the Department to have a control on the number of fish trader/agent operating in the State of Goa thereby protecting the interest of the local fishermen of the State.

### 1) Training Programme at Fisheries Training Centre Ela, Old Goa.

Every year 25 fisher youths are being trained in the Departmental Training course of 6 months duration with a stipend of Rs.1000/- per month as per the existing Pattern of Assistance. However, due to Covid Pandemic the above said training was not conducted last year.
