Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi participated in the Grand Final marking the culmination of 'Ujjwal Bharat Ujjwal Bhavishya – Power @2047' via video conferencing and launched the Revamped Distribution Sector Scheme and National Solar Rooftop Portal. He also laid the foundation stone of various green energy projects of NTPC. 'Ujjwal Bharat Ujjwal Bhavishya – Power @2047' which had commenced from [July 25th 2022](#), as part of ongoing 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' and celebrated across the country, to showcase the transformation in the power sector achieved in the last eight years.
