

Surveillance Campaign on Adulteration of Edible Oils.

The Directorate of Food and Drugs Administration (DFDA) has informed that, as part of the Surveillance Campaign on Adulteration of Edible Oils which has started in Goa on [August 01st](#), 2022; the Food Safety Officers have drawn 10 Samples on [August 03](#), 2022 of different varieties of Oils such as Extra light Olive Oil, Pure Mustard Oil, Multi Source Edible Oil, Extra Virgin Olive Oil, Vanaspati, Refined Sunflower Oil, Refined Rice Bran Oil; of different brands from the retail markets; from the Talukas of Canacona and Pernem

These Samples will be forwarded to the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) approved Food Testing Laboratory for Analysis.

The Sampling of Edible Oil products will continue till [August 14th](#), 2022.

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
