

DM ISSUES PROHIBITORY ORDERS FOR ZP BY-ELECTION

District Magistrate, South Goa has issued prohibitory orders under section 144 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

All restaurants, bars, tea shops, eateries and other food shops, / joints (Dhabas, Gaddas) etc., situated in 13 –Davorlim Zilla Panchayat Constituency in Salcete Taluka and 25 – Cortalim Zilla Panchayat Constituency in Mormugao Taluka of South Goa District jurisdiction within 200 mtrs of the polling stations on day of Poll i.e. on **October 16**, 2022 from 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. and the counting centre's on the day of counting i.e. on **October 18**, 2022 from 6.00 a.m. till end of counting of votes of respective Zilla Panchayat Jurisdiction in South Goa District will remain closed.

The DM has imposed ban on any gathering or crowd comprising of more than 5 persons within 200 meters of polling stations within the area of 13 – Davorlim Zilla Panchayat Constituency in Salcete Taluka and 25 – Cortalim Zilla Panchayat Constituency in Mormugao Taluka of South Goa District.

It is further directed that the above restrictions shall not apply to public servants on duty and to bonafide marriage or funeral processions or religious processions / functions. Also, the above order shall not apply to the authorized officers on Election Duty by the State Government, including the Polling Officials, Magistrates, Police Officials and Government Staff.
