This year, the Constitution Day is being celebrated on the subject of “India – the Mother of Democracy”.

For celebrating this occasion in a befitting manner, the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, New Delhi, has developed the following two web portals:-

These portals will be accessible to every citizen and anyone can participate and get certificates of participation.

The said function will be held in the open space of the Secretariat, wherein the Chief Secretary will read out the “Preamble” to the Constitution at 10:00 a.m. All Officers and Staff Members of the Secretariat and the Ministerial Block are requested to be present at the aforesaid venue, date and time for the function.

Further, as desired by the Ministry, all the HODs/Offices/Autonomous Bodies/Corporations are requested to read out the “Preamble” to the Constitution in their respective offices on the aforesaid date and time and to conduct any programs as deemed fit for the function.
