**MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS**

- 1. Construction of 100 bedded Hospital in Phase-II of Expansion at IPHB Complex at Bambolim under Centre of Excellence.**

The project is financed by the Centre and State Government through (Centre of Excellence, Manpower Development Scheme under NMHP) and is undertaken by GSIDC.

The GSIDC has awarded the construction work to M/s Tirupati Sarjan Limited, Gujrat.

- 2. Construction of Day Care Centre in IPHB, Bambolim.**

The said project is taken up by IPHB for rehabilitation of Mentally ill Patients and the same has been approved by the Government. The project is being undertaken by GSIDC.

The GSIDC has awarded the construction work to M/s Tirupati Sarjan Limited, Gujarat.

- 3. The construction of New Hostel Block in IPHB has been approved by Government and is being taken up by GSIDC for accommodating students for the newly approved courses such as (M.Phil in Clinical Psychology) (2) M. Phil in Psychiatric Social Work (3) Post Basic Diploma in Psychiatric Nursing under the Centre of Excellence, Manpower Development Scheme under NMHP.**

Two new courses viz. (i) M. Phil in Psychiatric Social Work and Post Basic Diploma in Psychiatric Nursing have already commenced.

- 4. The GSIDC has started the construction of Sewage Treatment Plant including sewage network at IPHB vide their work Order No. GSIDC/Engg/Works/1227/5715 dated 5<sup>th</sup> January 2022.**

The construction work of the Project in IPHB has been commenced and the stipulated date of completion is 14<sup>th</sup> January 2023.

5. 37 Medical officers from Directorate of Health Services were trained in the field of Psychiatry at IPHB.
6. Treated Asymptomatic and mild symptoms Covid Positive mentally ill patients at IPHB as per protocol.
7. Counselors under Directorate of Health Services were trained in Covid related Mental Health issues in Patients of Home Isolation.
8. Faculties and Resident Doctors participated in six camps “Administration at your Doorstep” organized by Government of Goa at various places in Goa .
9. Conducted Nine Psychiatric awareness programme at various PHC/CHC/Health Centres /Schools and colleges in Goa.
10. Faculty of IPHB participated in Round table discussion on Child Online Protection and safety organized by Human Touch Foundation.
11. Faculty of IPHB was the resource person for the webinar on “Asylum and communities in early Modern India” organized by the NIMHANS Heritage Museum, NIMHANS on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021
