Department of Handicrafts, Textile and Coir proposes to start orientation program in Handloom weaving in the villages of **Varkhand** in Pernem Taluka, **Assonora** village of Bardez Taluka, **Surla** Village in Bicholim Taluka, **Querim** village in Satari Taluka, **Kundaim** village in Ponda Takuka and **Ponda town** from 15th February 2023 onward.

Persons interested in learning the skill of handloom weaving may join the training program by submitting their applications in the prescribed format to the Inspector in the Department of Handicrafts, Textile and Coir, Panaji or through Swayampurna Mitra of the concerned Village Panchayat/Municipality on or before 15th February 2023. Eligibility for selection of trainees under the Scheme Vishwakarma Kaushal Yojana

1. Applicant should be having Domicile of Goa for 15 years
2. Vth Standard as Minimum Qualification
3. Age group of 18 to 45 years. However there will be no age restriction for traditional craftman of the State of Goa.

Traning will be imparted free of cost for the participants. Selected candidates would be paid with stipend of Rs. 1000/- for each completed month of trainee and for the SC/ST trainees, stipend paid would be Rs. 1500/- per month after successful completion of the training.
