

## RESTRICTION ON LIQUOR TRANSPORTATION

March 18, 2023

Phalgun 27, 1944

The Government has directed that no liquor shall be transported from one place to another within the areas of Jurisdiction of Ward No. V in V.P. Velguem, Ward No. VI, in V.P. Ona Maulinguem Kudchirem, in Bicholim Taluka; Ward No. VI in V.P. Orlim, Ward No. I in V.P. Rachol, in Salcete Taluka; Ward No. II, in V.P. Calem, in Sanguem Taluka; Ward No. IV in V.P. Balli-Adnem, Ward No. VII, in V.P. Barcem-Quedem, in Quepem Taluka and the maximum quantity of liquor i.e. the three quart bottles of Indian made foreign liquor or foreign liquor other than beer and six bottles of beer of 650 ml for any person including his family and three quart bottles of country liquor for any person including his family can be possessed by any person within the said areas without a permit issued in accordance with the provisions of the Goa Excise Duty Act, 1964.

The order shall remain in force on [March 24](#), 25 and 27, 2023 in view of Bye-Elections to seven vacant wards of Village Panchayats.
