

SALE OF LIQUOR PROHIBITED

The Government has directed that all the licensed premises "for the sale of liquor" will remain closed on [March 24](#), 25 and 27, 2023 within the areas of Jurisdiction of Ward No. V in V.P. Velguem, Ward No. VI, in V.P. Ona Maulinguem Kudchirem, in Bicholim Taluka; Ward No. VI in V.P. Orlim, Ward No. I in V.P. Rachol, in Salcete Taluka; Ward No. II, in V.P. Calem, in Sanguem Taluka; Ward No. IV in V.P. Balli-Adnem, Ward No. VII, in V.P. Barcem-Quedem, in Quepem Taluka in view of Bye-Elections to seven vacant wards of Village Panchayats 2023.

Further, the licensed premises having license for Bar and Restaurant are allowed to keep the Restaurant open for serving food only and the Bar counter shall be closed and no liquor shall be allowed to be served on the above mentioned days. The owners of the licensed premises having Bar and Restaurant shall display a board in the premises stating that No Liquor will be served and that only the Restaurant is open for serving food.
