

Monserrate Inaugurates LSR office at Dharbandora

The Office of the Inspector of Survey & Land Records was inaugurated [today](#) at the Government Complex Building in Dharbandora by the Minister for Revenue, Shri Atanasio Monserrate. This move is part of the government's initiative to provide better and faster services to the public.
