

PENALTY IMPOSED ON FBOS

The Director of FDA has informed that the District Magistrate cum Adjudicating Officer, South Goa, has imposed a fine of Rs. 2,00,000/-, on M/s. Bunge India Pvt. Ltd. (Manufacturer/Packer) Survey No. 151/1, 151/2, 151, 154/1, 154/2, and 157 National Highway 8A, Village Moti Chirai, Taluka Bhachav-370140, District – Kutch (Gujrat) for manufacturing and selling “Dalda Vanaspati”, which was declared “Sub-Standard”, on analysis.

The Adjudicating case was filed by the Food Safety Officer, Smt. Shruti Pilarnekar. Samples were drawn from M/s. Vijay General Store, H. No. 129, Ward No. III, Alto Dabolim, Mormugao – Goa. The Sample of “Dalda Vanaspati” was found failing in Synthetic Vitamin A < 0.1 IU/gm which is in less quantity than specified by regulations and violates the provision of Clause No. 2.2.6.1, Chapter 2 (Food Product Standards) of Food Safety and Standards Regulations, 2011, Compendium of Food Product Standards and Food additives dated 08/09/2022, violating Section 26(2) (ii)(v) and Section 27(1) of the said Act which is punishable under Section 51.
