

## NOMINATIONS INVITED FOR MAHAVEER AWARDS

Bhagwan Mahaveer Foundation, Tamil Nadu has invited nominations from eminent citizens of the country and administrators and the general public for 27<sup>th</sup> Mahaveer Awards. The awardees are selected by a Jury headed by Justice Shri M N Venkatachaliah, former Chief Justice of India.

Bhagwan Mahaveer Foundation is a Public Charitable Trust established by Shri Nugalchand Jain in 1994. The aim of the Foundation is to identify, encourage and honour individuals and institutions who are providing selfless service to the society and also encourage others to follow suit.
