

TUR/ARHAR & URAD IMPORTERS ADVISED NOT TO HOLD IMPORTED STOCK BEYOND  
30 DAYS

Department of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs has informed that the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi, has advised Tur/Arhar and Urad importers not to hold imported stock beyond 30 days from the date of Customs Clearance.

Also it has been directed that all the stockholding entities such as dealers, millers, importers, stockiest etc. in the State of Goa to upload stocks of pulses held by them on the online portal of the Department URI: <https://fcainfoweb.nic.in/psp> every Friday.

Further it has been informed that the undisclosed stocks held by millers, importers, stockiest etc. as well as stocks held by importers beyond 30 days from the date of Customs Clearance will be dealt with strictly by the Government.
